BYLAW 2004 - 02

VEHICLE WEIGHT MANAGEMENT BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

PART I-PURPOSE AND DEFINITIONS

Purpose

1. The purpose of this bylaw is to establish or adopt a vehicle weight management system to regulate the weight of vehicles, or vehicles with their loads, using a particular municipal highway in the municipality.

Definitions

2. (1) Except as hereinafter provided, words used in this bylaw shall have the meanings ascribed to them in The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 1999.

PART II-VEHICLE WEIGHTS


Weight limits on a Certain Road

3. The road shown on Appendix "A" of this bylaw and described as 'the road from Highway #41 to the access approach to the Louis Dreyfus Grain Terminal' shall be designated a road allowing primary weights year round and shall not be subject to spring road weight restrictions.
4. The weight of any vehicle shall not exceed the registered gross weight specified in the certificate of registration of that vehicle.

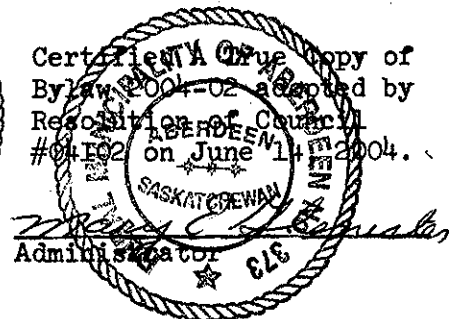
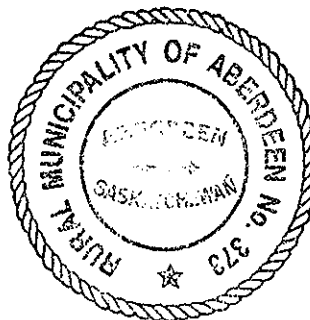
PART III-ENFORCEMENT

Penalty

5. (1) A person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence.  
(2) The penalty for breach of any provisions of this bylaw shall be those set out in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
