



RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373
BYLAW 2004 - 04

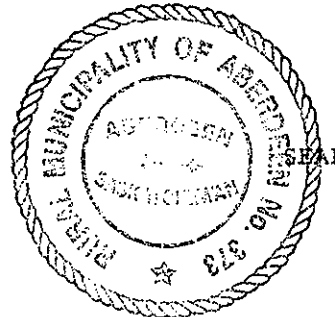
A BYLAW TO ENFORCE THE USE OF COVERS ON TRUCK BOXES AND TRAILERS UNDER THE
NOXIOUS WEEDS ACT.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen, #373, in the Province of
Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:


1. Before grain screenings and leanings of any kind is moved within the
Municipality, regardless of quantity, it must be covered in such a manner
as to prevent the spread of noxious weed seeds which it may contain.
2. Boxes and trailers of vehicles used to transport any of the materials
mentioned in paragraph (1) of this bylaw shall be covered with a
securely fastened tarpaulin or similar cover when moving anywhere
within the Municipality.
3. A legible card containing the provisions of this bylaw may be
conspicuously posted in all elevators, seed cleaning plants and seed
warehouses within the Municipality.
4. The owner and operator of any vehicle violating any provision of this
bylaw shall be guilty of an offense and shall be liable upon summary
conviction to a fine of not more than \$500.00, provided that a violator
of this bylaw, upon being served with a notice of violation, may at the
Municipal Office and during municipal office hours, pay a voluntary
reduced penalty of \$50.00 within 14 days of receiving a notice of
violation and may, upon payment so provided, thereby avoid
prosecution under this bylaw.
6. Bylaw #79 is hereby repealed.
