

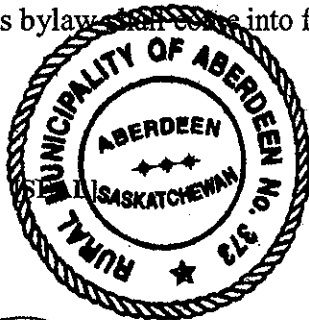


BYLAW NO 2014-02

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373; and
 - b) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373.
2. Council hereby appoints Michael Hulbert as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence July 10, 2014 and shall continue
 - o until such time that either party terminates the agreement.
 - o at the pleasure of council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving 30 days written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b) to represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw;
 - c) and other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on July 10, 2014

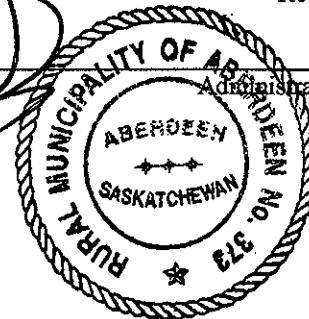





