

BYLAW NO. 79/3

A bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 authorizing Council to enter into an agreement to provide road ambulance service.

WHEREAS provision is made in the Rural Municipality Amendment Act, 1979, enabling the Council of any municipality to enter into a Municipal Road Ambulance District;

WHEREAS the Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 deems it expedient to enter into an agreement with:

- (1) THE CITY OF SASKATOON
- (2) THE VILLAGE OF ABERDEEN
- (3) THE TOWN OF ASQUITH
- (4) THE VILLAGE OF DALMENY
- (5) THE VILLAGE OF DUNDURN
- (6) THE TOWN OF HANLEY
- (7) THE TOWN OF MARTINVILLE
- (8) THE VILLAGE OF OSLER
- (9) THE TOWN OF VONDA
- (10) THE TOWN OF WARMAN
- (11) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283
- (12) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUNDURN NO. 314
- (13) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CORMAN PARK NO. 344
- (14) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373

to form a Municipal Road Ambulance District;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373 enacts as follows:

1. THAT the proposed agreement hereto annexed and marked as Schedule "A" to this bylaw, and which is deemed to be part of this bylaw, being an agreement between:

- (1) THE CITY OF SASKATOON
- (2) THE VILLAGE OF ABERDEEN
- (3) THE TOWN OF ASQUITH
- (4) THE VILLAGE OF DALMENY
- (5) THE VILLAGE OF DUNDURN
- (6) THE VILLAGE OF HANLEY
- (7) THE TOWN OF MARTINVILLE
- (8) THE VILLAGE OF OSLER
- (9) THE TOWN OF VONDA
- (10) THE TOWN OF WARMAN
- (11) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ROSEDALE NO. 283
- (12) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF DUNDURN NO. 314

(13) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF CORMAN PARK NO. 344


(14) THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373

(hereinafter called the "Participating Municipalities") be and the same is hereby ratified and confirmed.

2. THAT the Municipal Road Ambulance Board is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into an agreement with any person, corporation, volunteer organization or hospital board for the provision of road ambulance services, or to purchase and operate the required equipment for the purpose of providing road ambulance services.
3. THAT the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sign the said Municipal Road Ambulance Agreement on behalf of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 and affix thereto the corporate seal of The Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373.
4. THAT this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passage.
