

BYLAW 86-2

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS

WHEREAS by Section 3 of the Pest Control Act, the Minister of Agriculture may by order publish in the Saskatchewan Gazette declare any animal, insect or disease that he deems likely to be destructive to be a pest for the purposes of the said Act; and

WHEREAS the said Minister has the order published in the issue of the Saskatchewan Gazette for June 17, 1957 declared grasshoppers to be a pest for the purposes of the said Act; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality is of the opinion that grasshoppers are likely to appear within the municipality during the crop year in such numbers as to require control measures to prevent serious crop damages; and

WHEREAS power is vested in the Council of the municipality by Section "12" of the Pest Control Act, to enact bylaws for the control of any pest to which such Act relates;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Aberdeen #373 enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression;

"crop year" means the period from April 15th to October 15th of the same year; each year that the bylaw is in effect or until it is rescinded.

"department" means the Department of Agriculture for the province of Saskatchewan;

"owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the municipality.

2. That every owner within the municipality shall:

(a) Be responsible for controlling grasshoppers within the area lying between the center line of the road allowance adjoining the land and the nearest boundary of the land owned, occupied or controlled by him in the municipality; and shall apply insecticide on these infected areas in the manner recommended by the department.

(b) Apply insecticide to control grasshoppers to all of his land within the municipality and infested with these pests, including fields, trap strips, pasture, yards, waste places, fence lines and other areas in the manner recommended by the Department.

3. This bylaw is in effect until rescinded.

4. Bylaw 82-2 is hereby rescinded.
