


BYLAW NO. 8901

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE SPEED OF A MOTOR VEHICLE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such Act;
 - b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by The Highway Traffic Act.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than sixty (60) kilometres per hour on that portion of a public highway described as follows:

Commencing from the SE corner of the SE 1/4
13-40-02-W3rd extending west 450 metres,
along the grid road.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 88.6 shall be hereby repealed.






