BYLAH NO 8906

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, RESPECTING PLOUGHING, ENCUMBERING AND OBSTRUCTING ROADS.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within this municipality as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84, other than a provincial highway as designated pursuant to such Act.
- No person shall plough a road or portion thereof in the municipality except by written authority of the Council.
- No person shall encumber or obstruct a road in the municipality by leaving a vehicle, or other article or thing standing thereon.
- 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

5. Bylaw No. 88 is hereby repealed.
