


BYLAW NO. 9006

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ABERDEEN NO. 373 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING A SIGNING CORRIDOR

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as "SCHEDULE A", with the Town of Aberdeen for the purposes stated within the agreement.
2. The Reeve and the Administrator of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement, identified as "SCHEDULE A".
3. This bylaw shall have force and effect on the date of mutual signing of the attached agreement.

in the Province of Saskatchewan  
hereinafter referred to as "The R.M."

AND:  
THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN  
in the Province of Saskatchewan  
hereinafter referred to as "The Town"

WHEREAS the parties to this agreement wish to establish a highway signing corridor at the following locations:

1. To the north of provincial highway #41, on the S.W.1/4-31, Township 38, Range 2, West of the Third Meridian,
2. To the south of provincial highway #41, on the S.E.1/4-25, Township 38, Range 3, West of the Third Meridian,
3. To the south of provincial highway #41, on the N.E.1/4-25, Township 38, Range 3, West of the Third Meridian.

in order to provide local businesses and associations with a location to advertise publicly within the community.

NOW THEREFORE, the R.M. and the Town agree to such establishment under the following terms:

- a. All organization and administration of the signing corridor will be handled by the Aberdeen Chamber of Commerce.
- b. Any costs of operation shall be the responsibility of the Aberdeen Chamber of Commerce.
- c. Construction and operation of the signing corridor shall be done under Saskatchewan Highways and Transportation regulations.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the parties to this agreement have hereunto set their hands and seals at the Town of Aberdeen, in the Province of Saskatchewan, this 12th day of September, 1990.
