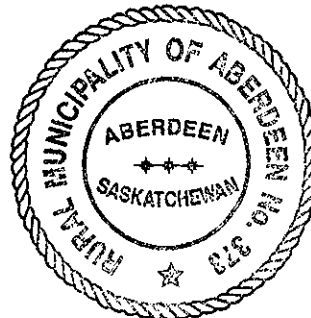
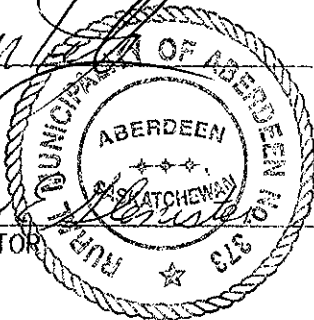
A bylaw to regulate the speed of motor vehicles within the hamlet of Edenburg

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "public highway" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highway Traffic Act*, but shall not include a provincial highway as designated in pursuance of such act;
 - (b) "motor vehicle" shall have the meaning ascribed to it by *The Highway Traffic Act*.
2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a greater speed than fifty (50) kilometers per hour on a public highway within the Hamlet of Edenburg.
3. Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected on all streets entering the subdivisions and shall be placed at the point of entry or commencement of the speed zone area.
4. Section 2 shall not apply to operators of fire engines, and fire department apparatus and operators of an ambulance where such vehicles are being operated on emergency duty and employing the siren and flashing red lights.
5. Any person guilty of an infraction of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalty provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw 79 6 is hereby repealed.
