Public Hearing

The purpose of the public hearing was to hear concerns/objections/representations regarding the proposed Bylaw 2026-06 being a Bylaw to Provide for the Closing and Leasing of a Road.

Summary of Comments or Concerns Received Opposing:

Restricting neighbouring landowners from access to their land. Will there be alternative access given to these landowners?
Bylaw does not identify what type of fence.
Fence has already been put in place – prior to bylaw being passed.
Applicant does not own land North or South of RM owned road allowance.
No municipal benefit to allowing this. Only benefits the landowner applicant. Would like RM to specify what is being achieved by agreeing to this.
Recommendation that council inspect this site in person prior to decision.
Concern that this does not follow existing bylaws.

Verbal Presentations:

Brian Jones gave a brief explanation that part of the existing fence is being replaced and that he would be agreeable to installing a gate if the council deems it to be necessary.
