HOW TO CHECK FOR LEAKING TOILETS

1. Flush your toilet as usual. Wait for the water to rise again to the designated water line of the tank and the toilet to fully complete the flush.
2. Drop 4-5 drops of red or blue food coloring in the toilet tank.
3. Replace the toilet lid and wait 15 minutes.
4. If the water in your toilet bowl is clear – there is no leak. If the water has changed color there is a leak.
5. Repeat the process with ALL toilets in the house, if applicable. This is very important to see if the issue is coming from one specific toilet or happening in multiple ones.

Spring Flooding

As spring approaches, so does the risk of flooding from the spring run offs. It is important to be prepared and to make sure you have a plan in place in case you do experience flooding. Here are a few tips to help you prevent and prepare in case of a flood.

1) Never store important documents or heirlooms in the basement. Keep them at a higher level, protecting from flood damage.

2) Check your sump pump and back up valves to insure that are in proper working order. If they are not working properly, fix or replace them.

3) Clear snow and ice from around the bottom of your downspouts and extend the downspouts at least two metres so that water drains

away from your foundation.

4) Always shovel snow away from your house and keep window wells clear of snow, and debris.

5) Have an Emergency Kit ready in case you need to be evacuated. Make sure to include clothing, water, nonperishable food, can opener, baby/child supplies (diapers, baby food, medications, etc.), blankets, Flash Lights, batteries, ID and health cards for yourself and any children, cash, first aid kit, cell phone and charger, etc. Keep the kit in a duffle bag placed where it can be easily and quickly accessible at a moment's notice.

6) Be prepared in case you become stranded in your home. Make sure you have enough provisions to be self-sustained for up to 5 days or more. If you are on medication, try to keep a week's supply on hand at all times.

The RM would like to ask for your patience and understanding while we deal with any road damage that may occur from the spring runoff. For your safety, DO NOT try to cross any road that may have water across it. Please contact your councilor or the RM Office to report any flooded roads. Please keep in mind that the RM of Aberdeen maintains 330 miles of road during the summer and, as such, it may take time before we are able to get to make all necessary repairs to roads.

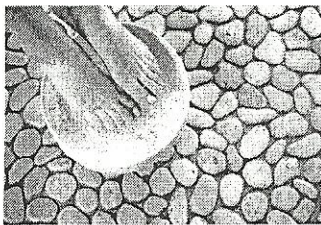

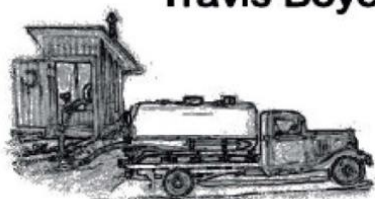

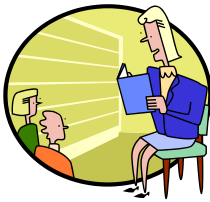

How do I subscribe?

Black and white copies are provided for free to anyone who rents a post office box from the Aberdeen post office. Don't have an Aberdeen post office box but want to receive a copy in the mail? You can subscribe for \$20/year. You can also subscribe to the electronic version (in colour) for free. Call or email the editor to be added to the mailing and/or electronic distribution list.

How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it. Please note that there may be minor changes to your ad for formatting purposes.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
 - a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), JPEG (.jpeg)
 - b. Narrow margins page set up.

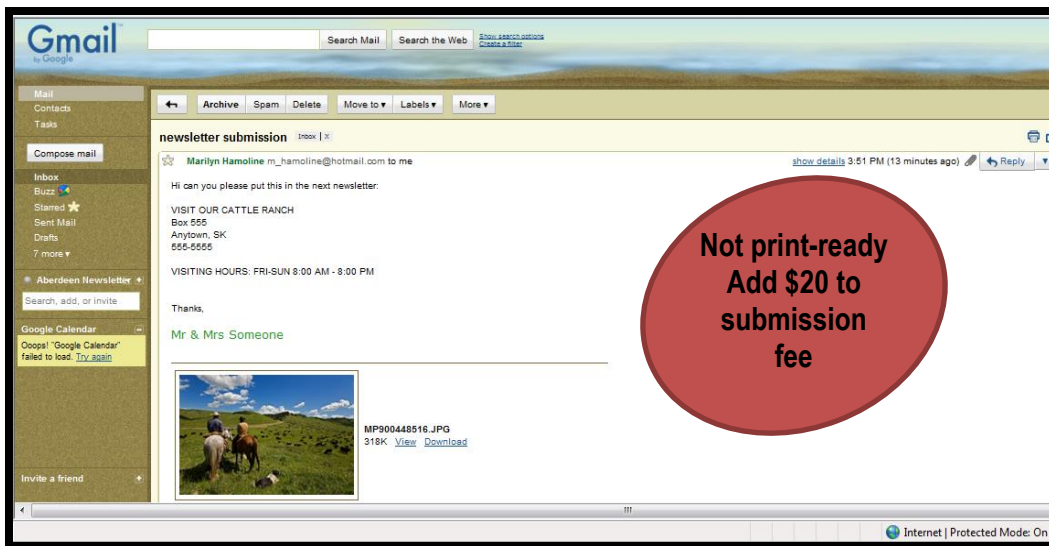

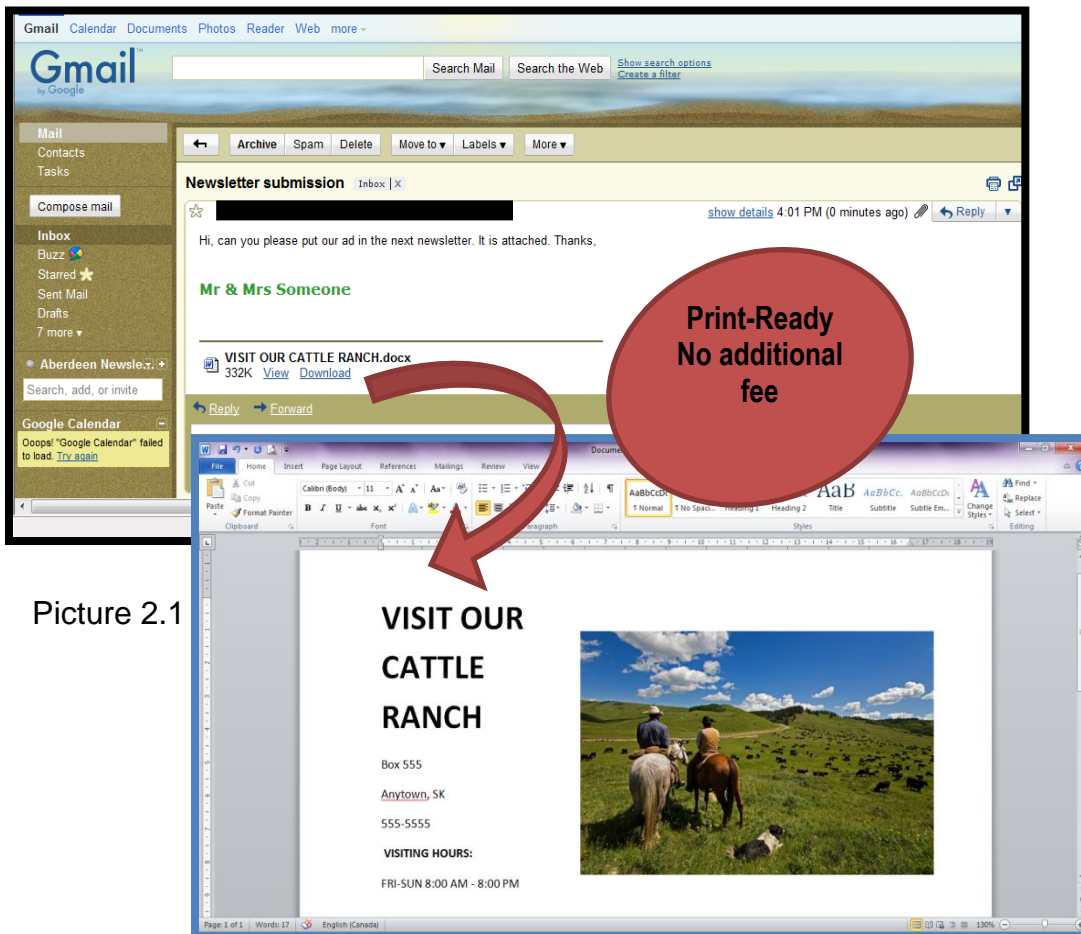
