SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

The Town Maintenance personnel will be doing snow removal Monday thru Friday (weekends by necessity only).

Priority will be given to the following . . .

- The School Route Central Ave, Main Street, 2nd Ave and Thompson Street
- *Emergency Services* Industrial Drive and 5th Ave South
- Followed by the Residential areas.

Snow removal becomes difficult when ...

- garbage/recycling carts are left out on the street (please remove them immediately after pick up)
- > vehicles left on the street for long periods of time (they cannot be left for a period exceeding 36 hours)
- all vehicles are required to PARALLEL PARK! Angle Parking in designated areas only (on Main ST, at Gido's, SoulWok and Town Office).
- > please keep clear sidewalks and areas where water reading pucks are located.

Note:

• Bylaw 03/13 prohibits any person from cleaning or sweeping snow from any private property onto the street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer. Those guilty of an offence may be fined \$250. Should you wish to remove snow from your property a designated dumping site is located on the empty lot at the Water Plant on the corner of Main St

EMO (Emergency Measures Organization)

The Town of Aberdeen is in the process of compiling a list of available resources should there be an emergency in Town. If you have any equipment or resources that would be useful in an emergency such as a Bobcat, generator, water truck, etc. OR are in the Health Care profession and could be of service, please call the Town of Aberdeen with your name and phone number and what you could offer in a time of need.

2015 PROPERTY TAX DISCOUNT

Are you interested in taking advantage of a discount? **Prepayment on your municipal portion of your taxes includes a 6.5% discount for January.** Please contact the Town Office for a pre-payment estimate or calculate the estimate based on your last years amount.

BACK ALLEYS

Back alleys are Town property and not a storage area! **Please have any items that you have placed in the back alley (such as campers, swings, slides, vehicles, garbage, etc) removed immediately before the snow falls**. Bylaw Enforcement officer will be visiting any property owners who have left items in the alley.

2015 DOG / CAT REGISTRATIONS

All dog and cat registrations are due annually. Non restricted dogs qualify for FREE registrations fees during the month of January. Fees still apply for restricted dogs.

After February 1, 2015 regular fees apply:

Non Restricted Dogs - \$25.00

Restricted Dogs - \$100.00

There are no registration fees for cats, but failure to register could result in a fine. Bylaw 01/07 states that failure to register your animals can result in fines of \$50.00 per animal.

Transfer Station Hours

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3.

The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable. Transfer Station is pay per use for household garbage. Please contact the RM Office for prices. Household recyclables and compostable materials may be taken free of charge if placed in the proper pile or bin.

The site is manned and the gate is locked at all times, except during operating hours as indicated. The municipality will not tolerate garbage being dumped on Municipal roads. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine.

Controlled Burn

Please notify the office at 306-253-4312 of **all** control burns within the RM. After hours and weekends, please contact the

deputy fire chief Adrien Hamoline at 306-230-1603. The RM of Aberdeen charges \$500 for ALL fire calls that have our Fire Fighters leave the fire hall. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. This can add up to thousands of dollars in a very short period of time. Contact your insurance provider to ensure you have sufficient firefighting coverage to protect yourself in case of fires.

Plowing Snow

As winter is approaching, we would like to remind everyone that plowing snow onto or across municipal right-of-way is NOT a permitted practice. Guilty Parties will be subject to Fines. Plowing snow across the roadways creates ridges that settle and harden, creating serious hazards to motorists, grader operators and potential damage to graders.

How do I subscribe?

Black and white copies are provided for free to anyone who rents a post office box from the Aberdeen post office. Don't have an Aberdeen post office box but want to receive a copy in the mail? You can subscribe for \$20/year. You can also subscribe to the electronic version (in colour) for free. Call or email the editor to be added to the mailing and/or electronic distribution list.

How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it. Please note that there may be minor changes to your ad for formatting purposes.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

- 1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
- 2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
- a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), JPEG (.jpeg)
- b. Narrow margins page set up.

How much does it cost to run an ad?

Business Card size \$25.00/10 issues

- 1. Quarter page or less \$8.⁰⁰/issue
- 2. Half page or less \$15.⁰⁰/issue
- 3. Full page or less \$30.⁰⁰/issue
- 4. ** payment due upon submission **
- 5. Preferred payment is cheque
