

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable. Transfer Station is pay per use for household garbage. Please contact the RM Office for prices. Household recyclables and compostable materials may be taken free of charge if placed in the proper pile or bin.

The site is manned and the gate is locked at all times, except during operating hours as indicated. The municipality will not tolerate garbage being dumped on Municipal roads. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine.

#### Ed Decker May25, 1945 - March 5, 2015

DECKER - Ed (Edward William Charles) Decker died March 5, 2015 at St. Paul's Hospital, Saskatoon, in the company of family and friends. Ed, aged 69, was born May 25, 1945 in Regina and grew up on the family farm near Bulyea with his parents, Fred and Millie Decker, and his brother, Ken. He attended the University of Saskatchewan which led him into a career in the credit union system. He served as manager of University Credit Union and went on to work in the commercial real estate field. Notable among his private entrepreneurial endeavours was opening the first skate board park in Saskatoon, well ahead of the craze. Ed also owned the insurance agency in Aberdeen, a community to which Ed and Marlene devoted themselves for many years. Ed served on town council and as mayor, organized community fundraising events, including the popular concerts performed by his friends Henri Loiselle and Martin Janovsky. He coordinated the community newsletter, served on the Chamber of Commerce and played an important role in Aberdeen's centennial celebrations. Ed was an active member of the Lutheran church in Strasbourg while he lived there, at Zion Lutheran church in Saskatoon and served the Lutheran Care Society (LuMinHoS) involved in hospital chaplaincy. For a year he and Marlene lived in Ghana and provided assistance to teachers in Ghana and the Gambia in establishing teachers' credit unions. A very important part of their lives was travelling the world with their friends.

Ed is predeceased by his wife, Marlene (2008). He is survived by his brother, Ken, of Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta, by nieces and nephews and by many, many friends. Ed requested there be no funeral but there will be a gathering to inter his ashes with a graveside service and to celebrate his life. This will be on Saturday, June 6 at Hillcrest Cemetery and Funeral Home. Gather at the front door of the Funeral Home at 2:00 p.m. to walk to the grave and the reception will follow in the Hillcrest reception room. If you wish to make a memorial donation, please consider the LutherCare Foundation, 1212 Osler St., Saskatoon S7N 0T9.

Ed's family and friends wish to express our sincere thanks to all the staff at St. Paul's Hospital the kidney transplant team, ICU and 6<sup>th</sup> floor, to CCU staff at Royal University Hospital and to Pastors Ron Bestvater and Randy Meissner for the wonderful care and compassion shown to Ed and to us.
