On January 1, 2017 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2016 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31. Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax <u>Estimate</u> Notices for 2017 taxes will be sent in December 2016. 2017 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

#### ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW – Bylaw No. 13-15

The Town of Aberdeen offers FREE registration in 2017 to all residents with pets (during the month of January ONLY)! All registration forms for cats and dogs must be completed OR updated if there are any changes. If you have no updates to report, you must still call in to re-register to take advantage of the incentive!

If you have not completed a registration form please contact the Town Office to obtain one. Every cat or dog must be registered annually. Please visit our website <u>www.aberdeen.ca</u> for our restricted animals list, and schedule of fees after February 1. <u>Our office receives numerous complaints about animals running at large. Please keep pets on your own property</u>!

#### ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE ACT


A person must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to operate an ATV in any public area.

Youth between the ages of 12 and 15 can operate an ATV but cannot drive on roads/streets and must be supervised by someone who holds a driver's license. Helmets must be worn by drivers and passengers at all times. No person shall operate an ATV:

(a) on any private land; or

(b) on any road/street or any portion thereof within town limits, except for the purpose of crossing the said roads / streets to the closest point of exit; (c) any municipal land in the municipality; and

(d) must not operate between the hours of 10:30pm and 7:00am.



# Next Council Meeting

December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016

Council meetings held the second Thursday of the month, unless changed by council. Meeting will start at 9:00 am. Council Meetings are open to public observation.

Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office the Friday prior to the meeting at the latest.

## Controlled Burn

There are new regulations for registering your controlled burn. To register your controlled burn, you must register it first with the municipality by calling 306-253-4312 or Adrien Hamoline after hours and weekends at 306-230-1603. Then, you must Register your Burn with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911. The Provincial Fire Centre has the ability to see where a call is coming from and if it's close to a reported controlled burn. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. It only takes a moment to make the call. DO NOT plan any controlled burns when the wind is blowing!!! The RM of Aberdeen charges \$500 for ALL fire calls that have our Fire Fighters leave the fire hall. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

## UPCOMING REFERENDUM

The Council for the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No 373 has received a Petition for a Referendum to have a vote to change the Division Boundary Lines within the municipality and decrease the number of councillors. As a result of the petition, Council for the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No 373 has passed the Bylaw No. 2016-03, A Bylaw to Provide for a Vote on a Question at the Regular Council Meeting held on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

Section 1 of the Bylaw states that the following question shall be submitted to a vote:

"That the Council of the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 request the Minister of Municipal Affairs of the Government of Saskatchewan to alter the divisional boundaries of the R.M. of Aberdeen No. 373 in accordance with the proposed divisional boundaries drawn on a map and the description of each new division as shown in the petition?

The vote for the referendum will take place on December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2016 between the hours of 9:00 am and 8:00 pm. The advance polls for the vote on the question shall be held on 3<sup>rd</sup> day of December, 2016 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Polling places will be the Municipal Office at 101 Industrial Drive in Aberdeen, the basement of the St Paul's Bergheim Evangelical Lutheran Church located across from Mission Ridge Phase 1 on Bergheim Road, and the Laniwci Hall located off of Fish Creek Road on the SW 1-41-02-W3.

The returning officer shall be present at the municipal office, 101 Industrial Drive in the Town of Aberdeen on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to designate voters that represent supporters and opponents to attend at the polling place and at the final summing up of the votes pursuant to section 149 of The Local Government Election Act, 2015.

The returning officer shall on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. at the municipal office, 101 Industrial Drive in the Town of Aberdeen declare the results of the vote.

Township 37 - In range 3, sections 1 to 12 inclusive. In range 2, all of sections 6 and 7.

Division 2:

Township 37 - In range 3 sections 13 to 24 inclusive. In range 2, all of sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and sections 8 to 24 inclusive.

Division 3:

Township 37 – In range 3 sections 25 to 36 inclusive. In range 2, section 25 to 36 inclusive. Township 38 – In range 3 sections 1 to 12 inclusive, In range 2, sections 1 to 12 inclusive.

Division 4:

Township 38 – In range 3 sections 13 to 36 inclusive. In range 2, sections 13 to 36 inclusive. Township 39 – All range 2 within the R.M. of Aberdeen No. 373.

Division 5:


Township 39 – All of range 3 and range 4 lying within the boundaries of the R.M. of Aberdeen No. 373.

Township 40 – All of range 2 and range 3 lying within the boundaries of the R.M. of Aberdeen No. | 373.

Township 41 - All of range 2 lying within the boundaries of the R.M. of Aberdeen No. 373.

## How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it. Please note that there may be minor changes to your ad for formatting purposes.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

- 1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
- 2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
  - a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), PIC (.jpeg, tiff, png, pdf)
