GARBAGE & RECYCLING RATE INCREASE

Due to landfill rate increases the garbage and recycling monthly charge will increase by \$1.00 to \$18. effective July 1, 2016.



ALL TERRAIN VEHICLE ACT

A person must be 16 years of age and hold a valid driver's license to operate an ATV in any public area.

NO one under the age of 12 can drive an all terrain vehicle in Town. Youth between the ages of 12 and 15 can operate an ATV but cannot drive on roads/streets and must be supervised by someone who holds a driver's license.



WATER RATE INCREASE

Since Bylaw 01/14 was passed in 2014 SK Water has increased water rates by 14%. Residents will see increases of approximately 10% (\$22/1000 gallons water and \$8/1000 sewer) later this year. Changes will be in effect once approved by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.

BUILDING PERMITS

Building season is upon us. Please remember that building permits are required and can be picked up at the Town Office.



Our maintenance staff do NOT do pin locates, please contact the office for a list of surveyors.

BYLAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES

The EPS Management officer will focus on enforcing getting yards cleaned up, in accordance with our Nuisance Bylaw 02/06. They will be looking at junked vehicles, untidy properties, dilapidated garages, etc. Please help in beautifying our Town.

TREES IN ALLEYS

Planting trees in back alleys along residential fence lines is NOT permitted. Clear access is required for maintenance and emergency vehicles. Bylaw Enforcement together with Maintenance personnel will be evaluating current situations where trees have become a problem.



GARBAGE AND RECYCLE BINS

Just a reminder that every black and blue bin has a number that corresponds to your civic addresses – please do NOT mix or trade any bin with your neighbor. ALSO, remove your bins from the street by Tuesday evening after Loraas pick-up.

ANGLE PARKING AREAS – Bylaw No. 01/12

- Main Street (North side only) from Central Avenue to Fifth Avenue.
- Fourth Avenue (West side) from Main Street to up to and including Lot 14.
- Fourth Avenue (East side) from Main Street to Lot 1 Block 4 up to alley way.
- Third Avenue (East side only) from 201A Third Avenue to 205C Third Avenue.

MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31. Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

For prompt payment of 2016 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

- Payments received in January 6.5% discount
- Payments received in February 5.5% discount
- Payments received in March 4% discount
- Payments received in April 3% discount
- Payments received in May 2% discount
- Payments received in June 1% discount
- Payments received in July .5% discount

Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office the day before the meeting at the latest.

Controlled Burn

There are new regulations for registering your controlled burn. To register your controlled burn, you must register it first with the municipality by calling **306-253-4312** or **Adrien Hamoline after hours and weekends at 306-230-1603**. Then, you must Register your Burn with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911**. The Provincial Fire Centre has the ability to see where a call is coming from and if it's close to a reported controlled burn. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. It only takes a moment to make the call. **DO NOT** plan any controlled burns when the wind is blowing!!! The RM of Aberdeen charges \$500 for ALL fire calls that have our Fire Fighters leave the fire hall. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Transfer Station Hours

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable. Transfer Station is pay per use for household garbage. Please contact the RM Office for prices. Household recyclables and compostable materials may be taken free of charge if placed in the proper pile or bin. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine. The Transfer Station is no longer accepting old Propane Tanks.

Garbage Bins

Garbage bins must be kept off the road allowance except for Tuesdays when garbage pickup is scheduled. Garbage bins left on the roads interfere with the road crew's ability to effectively maintain the roads and ditches. Garbage bins left on roadways can also serve as a safety hazard to other motorists. The Rural Municipality will not be responsible for any damages caused by the graders if your bins are not back a minimum of 150 feet from the center of the municipal right of way.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired building permits must be closed in a timely manner. To book an inspection, contact BuildTECH consulting & Inspections at 306-370-2824. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. **No Building is to be occupied until after it has had a final inspection and has been deemed safe to occupy by BuildTECH & the RM Council.**

Pest Control Officer/Weed Inspector

Denis Boyenko is the Pest Control Officer/Weed Inspector for the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen. Rat poison can be picked up at the Office during regular business hours. Please call Denis at 306-220-8996 to report all suspected rat infestations.

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps can be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner. All

Taxes

Tax Notices will be mailed out the first week of July. Please be advised that a 1% interest charge is being added on to any overdue taxes on the first of every month.

Discounts on the municipal portion for current tax payments are as follows:

If paid before July 31st, you will receive a 6% discount. If paid before August 31st, 5% discount. If paid before September 30th, 4% discount, and so on. All Taxes are due before December 31st of the current Tax Year.

Please ensure you notify the municipality of any change in address you may have recently had to ensure you receive your tax notice in time to receive your discount. If you have not yet provided a phone number to the RM, please do so thus we may contact you in case of emergency.

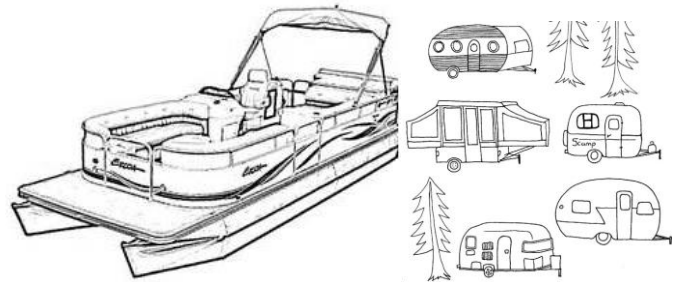

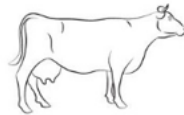

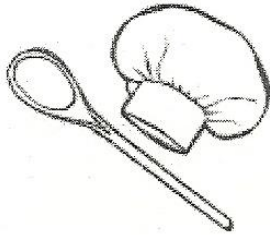

2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
 - a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), PIC (.jpeg, tiff, pngpdf)
