

Next Council Meeting September 8, 2016

Council meetings held the second Thursday of the month, unless changed by council. Meeting will start at 8:00 am. Council Meetings are open to public observation.

Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office the day before the meeting at the latest.

Elections:

This year, the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen No. 373 will be having elections for the position of Reeve and for the position of Councilor for Divisions 1, 3, and 5. Call for nominations will be from September 1st, 2016 until September 21st, 2016.

Nomination forms must be filled out correctly and received by the Nomination Officer no later than 4:00 pm on September 21st, 2016. Nomination forms can be picked up at the RM Office during regular business hours. Election Day will be October 26th, 2016. If you are unsure of your voting division, please contact the RM Office

Controlled Burn

There are new regulations for registering your controlled burn. To register your controlled burn, you must register it first with the municipality by calling 306-253-4312 or Adrien Hamoline after hours and weekends at 306-230-1603. Then, you must Register your Burn with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911. The Provincial Fire Centre has the ability to see where a call is coming from and if it's close to a reported controlled burn. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. It only takes a moment to make the call. DO NOT plan any controlled burns when the wind is blowing!!! The RM of Aberdeen charges \$500 for ALL fire calls that have our Fire Fighters leave the fire hall. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Transfer Station Hours

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable. Transfer Station is pay per use for household garbage. Household recyclables and compostable materials may be taken free of charge if placed in the proper pile or bin. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine. The Transfer Station is no longer accepting old Propane Tanks.

Garbage/Recycling Bins

Garbage bins must be kept off the road allowance except for the Mondays or Tuesdays when garbage/recycling pickup is scheduled. Garbage bins left on the roads interfere with the road crew's ability to effectively maintain the roads and ditches. Garbage bins left on roadways can also serve as a safety hazard to other motorist. The Rural Municipality will not be responsible for any damages caused by the graders if your bins are not back a minimum of 150 feet from the center of the municipal right of way.

Pest Control Officer

Denis Boyenko is the Pest Control Officer for the Rural Municipality of Aberdeen. Rat poison can be picked up at the Office during regular business hours. Please call Denis at 306-220-8996 to report all suspected rat infestations.

Animals on the loose

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps can be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

Taxes

Tax Notices were mailed out June 27th, 2016. Please be advised that a 1% interest charge is being added on to any overdue taxes on the first of every month. All costs resulting from tax enforcement of arrears will be added to the taxes.

Discounts on the municipal portion for current tax payments are as follows:

If paid before August 31st, 5% discount. If paid before September 30th, 4% discount, and so on. All Taxes are due before December 31st of the current Tax Year.

Please ensure you notify the municipality of any change in address you may have recently had to ensure you receive your tax notice in time to receive your discount. If you have not yet provided a phone number to the RM, please do so thus we may contact you in case of emergency.
