BUSINESS LICENSE - Bylaw No. 12-14



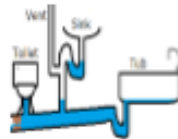
The Town of Aberdeen has adopted a new Business Bylaw 12-14 that addresses whether store front, home based, any trades or obtain a Business License.

All businesses must register with the Town of Aberdeen annually. Fees to **local businesses** located in Aberdeen were waived for 2015 **ONLY** – fees for 2016 are now due. All **non local** trades are subject to 2016 fees.

SEWER & WATER RATES BYLAW – Bylaw 12-15

Bylaw 12-15 introduces a new sewer rate structure that will implement a sewer charge based on the amount of water used.

This will eliminate the \$20 flat rate. **The new sewer charge is \$6.00 per 1000 gallons of water consumed.**



For example if you used 1000 gallons of water in a given month you would pay \$20/1000 for the water and effective January 1, 2016, \$6/1000 gallons for sewer.

MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.
Please remember there is **NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes**

For prompt payment of 2016 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

Payments received in January 6.5% discount
Payments received in February 5.5% discount
Payments received in March 4% discount
Payments received in April 3% discount
Payments received in May 2% discount
Payments received in June 1% discount
Payments received in July .5% discount

September 1	1%

On January 1, 2016 an additional 12% penalty was applied to 2015 arrears

ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW (License to Regulate Animals) – Bylaw No. 13-15

New in 2016 is Bylaw 13-15 which contains a few changes. Some new things to look for are: a schedule of prohibited animals, no “extra” fee for a restricted dog and a form for ALL animals to be filled out annually. Please review the Bylaw on our Town website and take note ALL the new requirements.

The license fee is an annual amount payable to the Town of Aberdeen effective from January 1 to December 31 of the current year. The Town of Aberdeen will offer as an incentive free registration during the month of January. After February 1 regular fees apply.

HOW TO CHECK FOR LEAKING TOILETS

1. Flush your toilet as usual. Wait for the water to rise again to the designated water line of the tank and the toilet to fully complete the flush.
2. Drop 4-5 drops of red or blue food coloring in the toilet tank.
3. Replace the toilet lid and wait 15 minutes.
4. If the water in your toilet bowl is clear – there is no leak. If the water has changed color there is a leak.
5. Repeat the process with ALL toilets in the house, if applicable. This is very important to see if the issue is coming from one specific toilet or happening in multiple ones.



ALSO, check ALL sinks and bathtubs for drips or worn out taps.

Plowing Snow

As winter is upon us, we would like to remind everyone that plowing snow onto or across municipal right-of-way is NOT a permitted practice. Guilty Parties will be subject to Fines. Plowing snow across the roadways creates ridges that settle and harden, creating serious hazards to motorists, grader operators, and potential damage to graders.

Transfer Station Hours

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable. Transfer Station is pay per use for household garbage. Please contact the RM Office for prices. Household recyclables and compostable materials may be taken free of charge if placed in the proper pile or bin.

The site is manned and the gate is locked at all times, except during operating hours as indicated. The municipality will not tolerate garbage being dumped on Municipal roads. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine.

Garbage Bins

Garbage bins must be kept off the road allowance except for Tuesdays when garbage pickup is scheduled. Garbage bins left on the roads interfere with the road crew's ability to effectively maintain the roads and ditches. Garbage bins left on roadways can also serve as a safety hazard to other motorists. The Rural Municipality will not be responsible for any damages caused by the graders if your bins are not back a minimum of 150 feet from the center of the municipal right of way.

One2One Health Clinic for Farm Families

The RM of Aberdeen is looking into hosting a One2One Respiratory or Hearing Clinic for Farm Families. *"The purpose of these clinics are educational, with a focus on increasing awareness of respiratory and hearing hazards on the farm, how to reduce risk from these exposures and how to maintain respiratory and hearing health."* Clinic would be open to males and females age of 18 years and older who are ratepayers. If you would like more information regarding this clinic, please contact our office by phone or email.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired building permits must be closed in a timely manner. To book an inspection, contact BuildTECH consulting & Inspections at 306-370-2824. **No Building is to be occupied until after it has had a final inspection and has been deemed safe to occupy by BuildTECH.**

Under Canada Soccer Association, Saskatchewan Soccer Association and Valley Soccer Association rules, players not released cannot participate in organized soccer because of insurance reasons. Big Sky Soccer will being the process at the local level but time is of the essence.

Big Sky Soccer Association has begun planning for the 2016 season and we still require board members, coaches, and volunteers to make our year a success. For a second year, annual meetings will be held in Aberdeen and Vonda and we encourage parents, players and referees to attend and provide their input as to how our organization is run in the district. 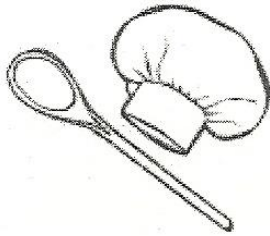

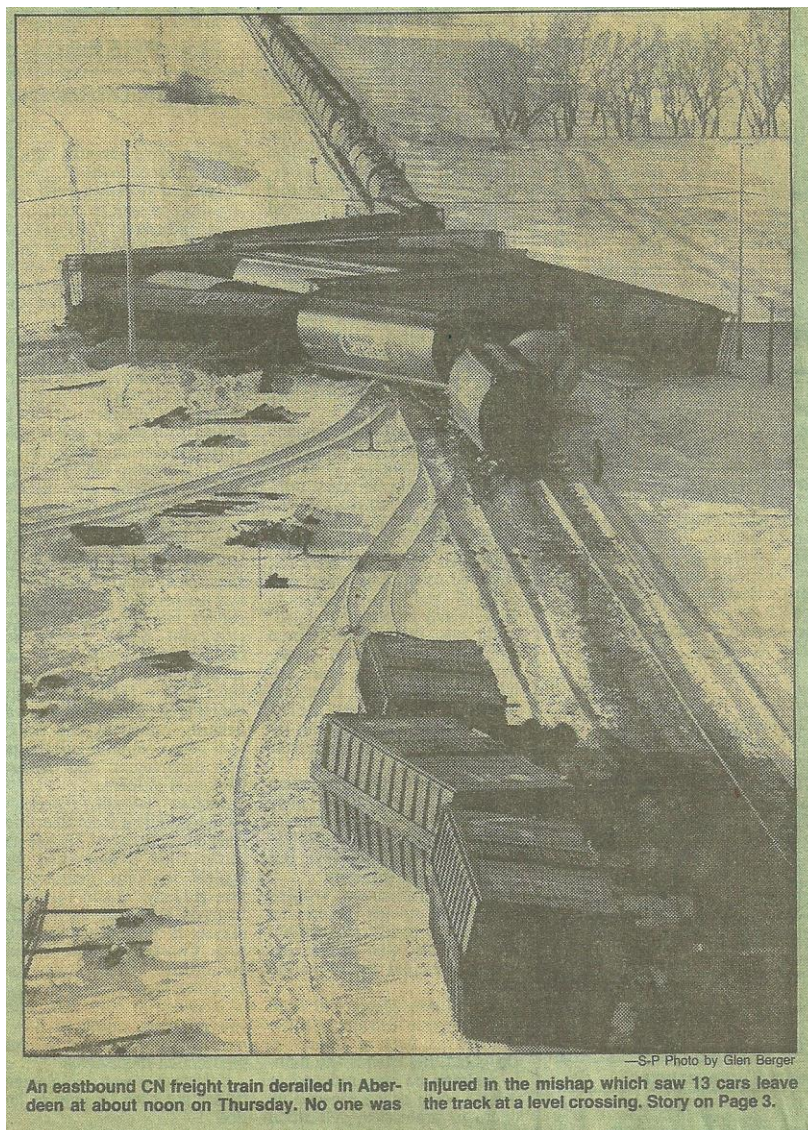

2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
 - a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), JPEG (.jpeg)
 - b. Narrow margins page set up.
