2017 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

For prompt payment of 2017 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

Payments received in January 6.5% discount
Payments received in February 5.5% discount
Payments received in March 4% discount
Payments received in April 3% discount
Payments received in May 2% discount
Payments received in June 1% discount
Payments received in July .5% discount



Penalties for 2017 Tax arrears will be as follows:

August 1 (compounded monthly)	1%
September 1	1%
October 1	1%
November 1	1%
December 1	1%

On January 1, 2017 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2016 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2017 taxes will be sent in December 2016. 2017 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

ANIMAL CONTROL BYLAW – Bylaw No. 13-15

The Town of Aberdeen offers **FREE** registration in 2017 to all residents with pets (during the month of January ONLY)! All registration forms for cats and dogs must be completed OR updated if there are any changes. If you have no updates to report, you must still call in to re-register to take advantage of the incentive! If you have not completed a registration form please contact the Town Office to obtain one. Every cat or dog must be registered annually. Please visit our website www.aberdeen.ca for our restricted animals list, and schedule of fees after February 1. **Our office receives numerous complaints about animals running at large. Please keep pets on your own property!**

2017 BUSINESS LICENSE - Bylaw No. 12-14

The Town of Aberdeen Business Bylaw 12-14 requires all businesses whether store front, home based, any trades or professions to obtain a Business License.

All businesses must register with the Town of Aberdeen annually. Failure to do so may result in fines. Fees to **local businesses** located in Aberdeen and all **non local** trades are subject to 2017 fees. **All current local businesses MUST be registered by January 31, 2017.**

Controlled Burn

There are new regulations for registering your controlled burn. To register your controlled burn, you must register it first with the municipality by calling 306-253-4312 or **Adrien Hamoline after hours and weekends at 306-230-1603.** Then, you must Register your Burn with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.** The Provincial Fire Centre has the ability to see where a call is coming from and if it's close to a reported controlled burn. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. It only takes a moment to make the call. **DO NOT** plan any controlled burns when the wind is blowing!!! The RM of Aberdeen charges \$500 for ALL fire calls that have our Fire Fighters leave the fire hall. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Tax Notices were mailed out June 27th, 2016. Please be advised that a 1% interest charge is being added on to any overdue taxes on the first of every month. All costs resulting from tax enforcement of arrears will be added to the taxes. To avoid Tax Enforcement, all current taxes must be paid prior to December 31st.

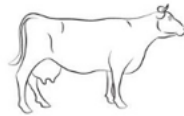

ABERDEEN AND DISTRICT FIRE AND RESCUE

A few helpful hints from your local fire department

- Gas, Propane, Wood furnaces -
Pull off the inspection cover and check for separation of seams.
- Wood Stove -
Take stove pipe off chimney pipe and check for build up of creosol. Remember burn only cured wood.
- Electric heater -
Check for broken insulation/cracked wiring.
- Keep live Christmas trees well watered, check Christmas lights before decorating---discard any sets that are frayed or damaged.
- Candles can set the perfect mood for a holiday celebration, but remember to always blow out candles before leaving the room or going to bed.
- Keep combustible items away from heat sources.
- Test smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors monthly - push the test button.
- Install new batteries yearly in smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors.
- Smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors should be replaced every ten years.
- Check fire extinguisher for expiration date.
- Keep clutter and combustibles out of the basement, particularly away from furnaces and hot water heaters.
