Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax <u>Estimate</u> letters for 2017 taxes were sent in December 2016. 2017 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

# WANTED - "Staging Manager" for EMO

The Town and District of Aberdeen are seeking a volunteer to act on the Emergency Measures Organization team as a "Staging Manager". The volunteer would ideally be a person who is organized, can work independently and be able to record incoming and outgoing personnel and equipment. The role is an important position as it helps the Emergency Operations Centre in town know where all resources are and what is available to use. The time commitment would be only about 1.5 hrs per month from September until June to attend EMO meetings held in Aberdeen. If a largescale emergency occurred which required activation of the Emergency Operations Centre, the volunteer (along with all other EOC volunteers) would be needed to meet at the Emergency Services Building for the duration of the emergency. In the past three years, we have never been activated but as in the Calgary flood, the Fort Mac fires and the LaRonge fires have shown it can happen anywhere without warning. We would only be activated for a large-scale emergency affecting The Town and District of Aberdeen. #### CLEAN WATER AND WASTE WATER FUND


In Dec./14 the Town of Aberdeen applied for \$3,000,000 in infrastructure funding for a new lagoon & lift station under the New Building Canada Fund. Unfortunately, we didn't get selected in the 1st phase. In Nov./16 we were made aware of a new funding program called CWWF, and we applied again, and WOW, we received a call at the end of Dec. and were told that we had been approved. The Federal government will provide \$1,500,000, Province \$750,000 and the balance \$750,000 falls on the Town of Aberdeen. In April/12 Town Council addressed a need and began collecting an infrastructure fee that to date has accumulated \$364,000. We are very happy to announce that we are well on our way to funding our portion of this much-needed infrastructure project. We will continue to work hard to meet the growing needs of this great community! If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the Town Office or any member of Town Council.

## 2017 BUSINESS LICENSE - Bylaw No. 12-14

The Town of Aberdeen Business Bylaw 12-14 requires all businesses whether store front, home based, any trades or professions to obtain a Business License.

All businesses must register with the Town of Aberdeen annually. Failure to do so may result in fines. Fees to <u>local businesses</u> located in Aberdeen and all <u>non-local</u> trades are subject to 2017 fees. The deadline to register was January 31, 2017 – PLEASE DO SO IMMEDIATELY!

# Controlled Burn

To register your controlled burn, you must register it first with the municipality by calling 306-253-4312 or Adrien Hamoline after hours and weekends at 306-230-1603. Then, you must Register your Burn with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911. The Provincial Fire Centre has the ability to see where a call is coming from and if it's close to a reported controlled burn. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in adjacent fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, ALL costs and charges will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Road Crew Foreman: Darryl Klassen Transfer Station-Regulation Changes

Beginning February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017, the transfer station will be free of charge for all RM Ratepayers. Tokens may be returned for a refund prior to February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017. No refunds will be given after February 1<sup>st</sup>. RM ratepayers wishing to use the Transfer Station must have a User Card. User Cards can be picked up at the RM Office during regular business hours. Cards are only valid from January 1<sup>st</sup>-December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year they were issued and must be renewed yearly in January.

Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for household refuse which is not recyclable or burnable. Several sites have been marked for items such as white metal, burnable etc. Painted wood is not considered as burnable.

The site is manned and the gate is locked at all times, except during operating hours as indicated. The municipality will not tolerate garbage being dumped on Municipal roads. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine. The Transfer Station is no longer accepting old Propane Tanks.

# Garbage Bins

Garbage bins must be kept off the road allowance except for Tuesdays when garbage pickup is scheduled. Garbage bins left on the roads interfere with the road crew's ability to effectively maintain the roads and ditches. Garbage bins left on roadways can also serve as a safety hazard to other motorist. The Rural Municipality will not be responsible for any damages caused by the graders if your bins are not back a minimum of 150 feet from the center of the municipal right of way.

# Building Permits

BuildTECH will no longer be looking after our Building Permits. BuildTECH has reorganized its company to split it into 2 territories. All permits on this side of the river will now be looked after by MA Inspections. Jason Kent will continue to be the building official looking after this territory. All permit processes and requirements will continue in the same manner.

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired building permits must be closed in a timely manner. To book an inspection, contact **MA Inspections** at 306-250-1092. No Building is to be occupied until after it has had a final inspection and has been deemed safe to occupy by the Building Officials.

You can subscribe for \$20/year. You can also subscribe to the electronic version (in colour) for free. Call or email the editor to be added to the mailing and/or electronic distribution list.

# How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it. Please note that there may be minor changes to your ad for formatting purposes.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

- 1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
- 2. Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
  - a. Accepted formats: Microsoft Publisher (.pub), Word (.doc), Excel (.xls), PIC (.jpeg, tiff, png, pdf)
