Meteor Shower

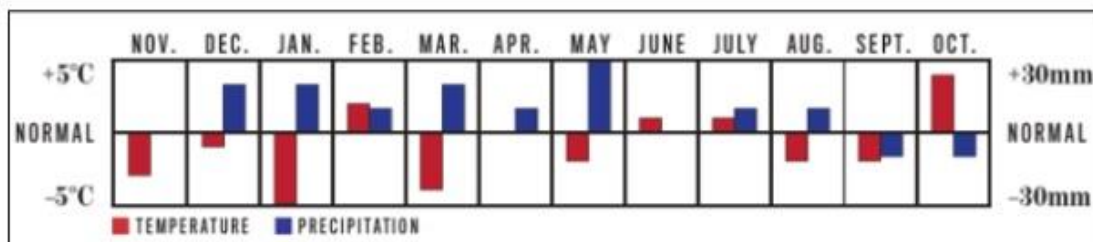
Dec 13–14, 2018

Controlled Burn

1. Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to issue a \$500 fine. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Civic Address Signs

Civic address signs are currently being installed throughout the RM.

*******Please be aware if you used an old civic address as your service address for your security system providers or utilities providers, you will need to contact them to update your civic address. If emergency services receive a call to your old civic address, they may not be able to locate your property. *******

Taxes

Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2018. All payments must be received or the envelope must be date stamped by Canada Post prior to the last day of the month. Please be advised that a 1% interest charge is added on to overdue taxes on the first of every month. **Please notify the municipality of any change in your address to ensure you receive your tax notice in a timely fashion. If you have not yet provided a phone number to the RM, please do so thus we may contact you in case of emergency.**

Please note that all unpaid invoices will be added to the landowner taxes if not paid by December 31, 2018

Garbage Bins

Garbage bins must be kept off the road allowance except for the days when garbage/recycling pickup is scheduled. Garbage bins left on the roads interfere with the road crew's ability to effectively maintain the roads and ditches. Garbage bins left on roadways can also serve as a safety hazard to other motorists. The Rural Municipality will not be responsible for any damages caused by the graders if bins are not back a minimum of 150 feet from the center of the municipal roadway.

Pest Control Officer

As the weather turns colder, pests will be looking for a warm place to stay and a steady source of food. If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

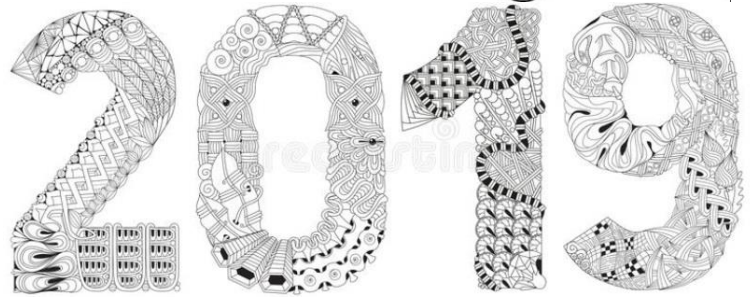

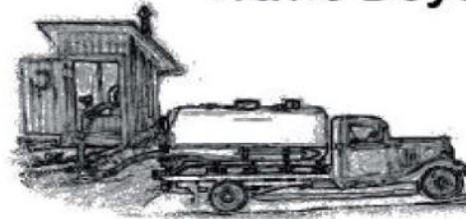

How do I subscribe?

Black and white copies are provided for free to anyone who rents a post office box from the Aberdeen post office. Don't have an Aberdeen post office box but want to receive a copy in the mail? You can subscribe for \$20/year. You can also subscribe to the electronic version (in colour) for free. Call or email the editor to be added to the mailing and/or electronic distribution list.

How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad, make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
