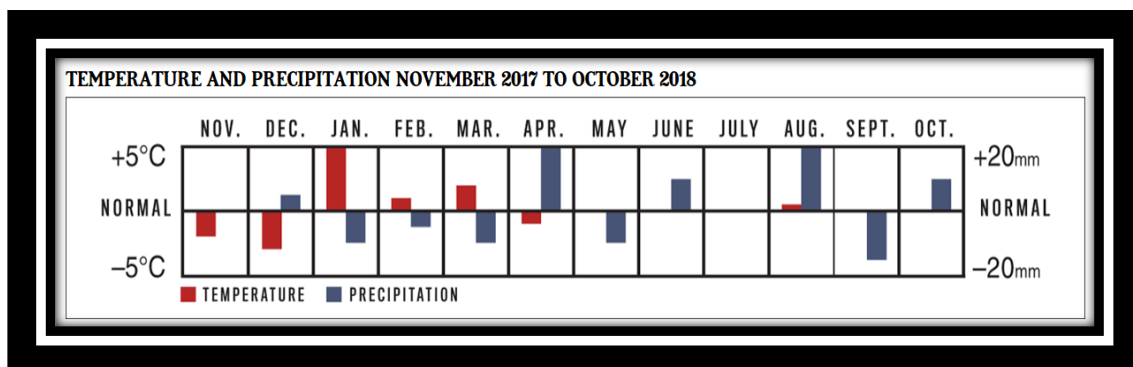

BUILDING PERMITS

Building season is upon us. Please remember that building and development permits are required and can be picked up at the Town Office. *Our maintenance staff do not do pin locates, please contact the office for a list of surveyors.*

 **REMINDER...according to our New Animal Control Bylaw 07/2017 all owners of cats and dogs must pay a ONE TIME \$25 permanent license fee PER animal (Lifetime validation). Please call the Town Office at (306)253-4311 should you have any questions**

Utility, Tax, & General Receipting

As of Jan. 1/18, the Town Office will no longer be mailing receipts, in an attempt to save postage costs. In 2016 over \$6,500 was spent on sending invoices and receipts alone. All e-transfers automatically send an acceptance receipt and online payments are recorded on your bank statement. For any residents paying by cash or cheque a receipt will be mailed to you should you require it for record keeping purposes.

For those of you that have not yet signed up for e-billing please contact the Town Office for a consent form.

If you are taking loads to the Transfer Station, please ensure your load can be unloaded before 4:45 as they close at 5:00pm. They are open 10:00am to 5:00pm Wednesday and Saturday.

MUNICIPAL/SCHOOL TAX ARREARS

Did you know? If you do not pay your taxes that it does not affect your credit rating? Unfortunately, it DOES affect how your community can operate.

Our 2017 Tax Levy was **\$564,754.30**

As of **Dec. 31/17**, almost **\$156,000** in Municipal taxes were still outstanding and almost **\$21,750** was owed to your local School Divisions.

We currently have **6** properties in Tax Enforcement

On January 1, 2018 a 12% penalty was applied to 2017 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate letters for 2018 taxes were sent in December 2017. 2018 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

Controlled Burn

1. Register with the municipality: call **306-253-4312** or at **306-230-1603 after hours and weekends**.
2. Register with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911**. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. Contact MA Inspections at 306-250-1092 or office@mainspections.ca to book an inspection. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. Taxes

2018 Taxes will be levied in June/July 2018. Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2018. A discount of 6% on the municipal portion is offered for payment in July, 5% in August, etc.; no discount is offered in December. All payments must be received on the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

Currently, the civic address will **only** be used by emergency response teams; it is not yet recognized by mail delivery companies including Canada Post. Your civic address can be found on your Tax Notice or can be obtained by contacting the RM office.

Sask Municipal Hail Association

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31st. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the Municipal office.

The RM of Blucher is allowing ratepayers from the RM of Aberdeen (with valid user cards) to use the waste transfer station located at NW 24-36-03-W3. 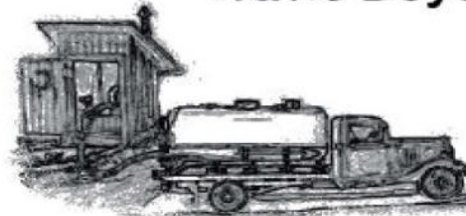
