

#### **BUILDING PERMITS**

REMINDER...according to our New Animal Control Bylaw 07/2017 all owners of cats and dogs must pay a ONE TIME \$25 permanent license fee PER animal (Lifetime validation). If you are taking loads to the Transfer Station, please ensure your load can be unloaded before 4:45 as they close at 5:00pm. They are open 10:00am to 5:00pm Wednesday and Saturday.

# MUNICIPAL/SCHOOL TAX ARREARS

Did you know? If you do not pay your taxes that it does not affect your credit rating? Unfortunately, it DOES affect how your community can operate.

Our 2017 Tax Levy was **\$564,754.30** As of **Dec. 31/17,** almost **\$156,000** in Municipal taxes were still outstanding and almost **\$21,750** was owed to your local School Divisions.

# Utility, Tax, & General Receipting

As of Jan. 1/18, the Town Office will no longer be mailing receipts, in an attempt to save postage costs. In 2016 over \$6,500 was spent on sending invoices and receipts alone. All e-transfers automatically send an acceptance receipt and online payments are recorded on your bank statement. For any residents paying by cash or cheque a receipt will be mailed to you should you require it for record keeping purposes.

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31. Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax <u>Estimate</u> letters for 2018 taxes were sent in December 2017. 2018 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.

- Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or at 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
- Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. ### <u>Taxes</u>

Currently, the civic address will **only** be used by emergency response teams; it is not yet recognized by mail delivery companies including Canada Post. Your civic address can be found on your Tax Notice or can be obtained by contacting the RM office.

#### Sask Municipal Hail Association

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31<sup>st</sup>. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the Municipal office.

Black and white copies are provided for free to anyone who rents a post office box from the Aberdeen post office. Don't have an Aberdeen post office box but want to receive a copy in the mail? You can subscribe for \$20/year. You can also subscribe to the electronic version (in colour) for free. Call or email the editor to be added to the mailing and/or electronic distribution list.

### How do I submit an ad?

If you have an ad that is currently in print that you need to make changes to, please make changes and re-submit as a new ad. When submitting your ad, make sure it is print ready as it will appear how you submit it.

There are two ways to submit your advertisement:

- 1. Drop off a hard copy of your ad to the Aberdeen Post office
- Email your ad as an attachment (preferred method)
