

### **Taxes**

2018 Taxes will be levied in June/July 2018. Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2018. A discount of 6% on the municipal portion is offered for payment in July, 5% in August, etc.; no discount is offered in December. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

### **Transfer Station** Please note important change: **STRETCHY PLASTIC IS NOT ALLOWED IN RECYCLE BINS and must be added to regular garbage.**

Please ensure you have renewed your user card for 2018. Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. All refuse must be unloaded by 5:00pm – the gate locks at this time. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage. The RM of Blucher is allowing ratepayers from the RM of Aberdeen (with valid user cards) to use the waste transfer station located at NW 24-36-03-W3. The RM of Aberdeen will be covering the cost to use this station. The list of accepted items applies to both transfer stations and can be found online.

### **Spring Weight Restrictions**

The spring road bans are in effect. Any costs incurred to repair damaged roads will be charged back to anyone caught damaging the municipal roads. Be advised that Drews Rd, Old 27 Rd, and Bettker Rd all have 10 ton limits. Please check our website or Facebook page for notification pertaining to the spring road restrictions. ### **Building Permits**

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. Contact MA Inspections at 306-250-1092 or [office@mainspections.ca](mailto:office@mainspections.ca) to book an inspection. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. ### **Property Assessments**

All properties are revaluated by the Saskatchewan Assessment Management Agency (SAMA) based on a four-year cycle. 2017 was a revaluation year. Only properties with changes over the past year will have Assessment Notices mailed to you in 2018. The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by SAMA. Your assessment notice will have the appeal form on the back of the sheet as well as the deadline for an appeal. The 2018 Deadline to appeal will be 30 days from the mailing date of the assessment notice. **This notice and time-frame is the only opportunity for appealing assessments during the year.** If you disagree with the property value established by SAMA, there is a formal appeal process available to you. Appeals must be based on an error in your property assessment and not based on the amount of taxes paid for the property. ## FLOOD PREVENTION

Individual Property Owners:

- Clear neighbourhood storm water catch-basins, where present, to help water drain.
- Shovel or remove snow from around your home and move it to a position where melt water will drain away from the foundation.
- Ensure downspouts are extended so they discharge rain or melt water a minimum distance from your home to avoid it draining back towards your foundation. The suggested minimum distance is two metres.
- Check to make sure your sump pump is working. If you don't have a sump pump consider installing one. Contact a plumber for assistance if needed.
- Consider installing a mainline Sewer Backwater Valve to protect against sewer backup.
- Keep basement sewer caps in place.

Check your basement regularly for signs of water and consider installing a water-sensing alarm




The purpose of School Community Councils is to:


