Controlled Burn

1. Register with the municipality: call **306-253-4312** or at **306-230-1603 after hours and weekends**.
2. Register with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911**. If a passing motorist phones in to report a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. Taxes

2018 Taxes will be levied in June/July 2018. Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2018. A discount of 6% on the municipal portion is offered for payment in July, 5% in August, etc.; no discount is offered in December. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

Transfer Station

RM ratepayers wishing to use the Transfer Station must have a User Card (available at the RM office during regular business hours). Cards are only valid from January 1st -December 31st of the current year and

must be renewed annually. Open Wednesday and Saturday from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Located on the SW 12-39-03-W3. The transfer site has a waste disposal bin for *household refuse* which is not recyclable or burnable. The site is manned and the gate is locked at all times, except during operating hours as indicated. There is a \$500.00 fine for anyone caught dumping garbage in the municipality, and the municipality will prosecute anyone that fails to pay the fine. The Transfer Station does **not** accept old propane tanks, bale wrap/netting or grain bags. The RM of Blucher is allowing ratepayers from the RM of Aberdeen (with valid user cards) to use the waste transfer station located at NW 24-36-03-W3. The RM of Aberdeen will be covering the cost to use this station. The list of accepted items applies to both transfer stations.

Civic Addressing

Civic addressing signs will be ordered in the new year. Currently, the civic address will **only** be used by emergency response teams; it is not yet recognized by mail delivery companies including Canada Post. Your civic address can be found on your Tax Notice or can be obtained by contacting the RM office.

Sask Municipal Hail Association

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31st. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the Municipal office.
