12th-15th.

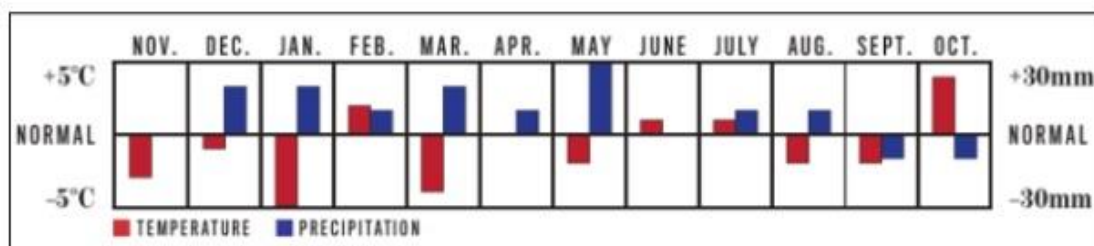
Cold weather overspreads the Prairies.

Auditor Confirmation Letters

Auditor confirmation letters have been sent out by Cogent Chartered Professional Accounts LLP to all ratepayers that had outstanding balances owing on December 31st, 2018. These letters are sent out by the accountants contracted to perform the RM's yearly audit to confirm the amounts the RM showed as outstanding on Dec 31st. Anyone whose payment for 2018 taxes was received in January 2019 will still be receiving an auditor's confirmation letter from our auditor. These letters are not account statements and anyone who still has an amount outstanding will have interest penalty accumulated on the outstanding amount. Please contact the RM office to obtain the full amount outstanding with the penalty prior to making a payment.

Sask Municipal Hail Association

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31st. Withdrawal forms may be obtained from the Municipal office.



Controlled Burn

1. Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire.

Utility, Tax, & General Receipting

As of Jan. 1/18, the Town Office no longer mails receipts, in an attempt to save postage costs. In 2017, \$6,564 was spent on postage alone. In 2018 we saved \$3,919.57 in postage part of this by not mailing out 2,414 receipts and 1,252 bills.

All e-transfers automatically send an acceptance receipt and online payments are recorded on your bank statement.

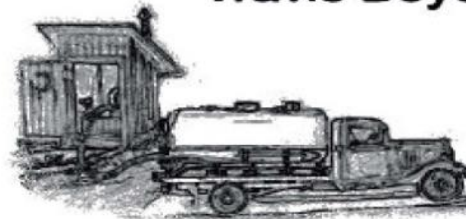
