




These letters are not account statements and anyone who still has an amount outstanding will have interest penalty accumulated on the outstanding amount. Garbage & Recycling Bins



Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the

2020 Business Licenses

Business Licenses were due December 31,2019 for 2020. Fines will be issued if not paid immediately. According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2020 are due December 31, 2019, and are valid until December 31, 2020.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw

Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

SNOW CLEARING

Residents may help by clearing the front of their property where sidewalks exist. Bylaw 03/13 prohibits residents from placing any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer.

Many times the Town Office receives calls from residents regarding the snow removal equipment depositing snow at the end of driveways. Unfortunately, this is a reality of snow plowing, and it cannot always be avoided. If you have a neighbor who is unable to remove their snow from in front of their driveway please assist them, as we often to not have the resources to go back and clear driveway approaches. We ask for your cooperation and understanding as our staff performs the work of keeping our streets open and safe during the winter.

SNOW REMOVAL PRIORITY

Snow removal will be done whenever there is an accumulation of 3 or more inches of snow on roadways from Monday thru Friday, and weekends by necessity only. Sand/gravel will be spread on streets and corners where icy, and as needed...

Priority 1 School Route - Central Avenue, Main Street, Second Avenue and Thompson Street

Priority 2 Emergency Services - Industrial Drive, Fifth Avenue South

Priority 3 Residential Streets

Priority 4 Alleys where required

Please Note; A layer of snow on roadways is not a bad thing, it helps protect the underground infrastructure such as sewer and water lines from freezing up in frigid temperatures.

Outstanding Building Permits

There are a large number of outstanding building permits throughout the Town of Aberdeen. Many of these permits have construction deficiencies, which have still not been addressed, and some just need a final inspection. The Town is required by provincial legislation to enforce the National Building Code to ensure safe construction standards are met. Therefore, it is important for you to complete the work as listed on your last building inspection report from MuniCode Services and then call them at (306) 955-6355 to arrange a final inspection. If your project is not near completion and can't meet the 1-year permit deadline, please call the Town Office at (306) 253-4311 to ask for an extension to complete the project.

If you are unsure whether your property has any permits that have not been dealt with please check by calling the Town Office.

Please note: Should you go to sell your home these deficiencies and outstanding permits will come up on a Property Information Disclosure and could potentially stop the sale.

On January 1, 2020 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2019 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax <u>Estimate</u> Notices for 2020 taxes were sent in December 2019. 2020 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.
