



Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office. Please note that MA Inspections has merged with BuildTECH Consulting & Inspections Inc. and BuildTECH will be taking over all open building permit files. If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

Spring Ratepayers Supper

After much discussion, Council feels it would be in the best interest of the ratepayers to postpone the Annual Ratepayers Supper usually scheduled in April, due to the concerns surrounding COVID-19. The new date is still to be determined.

Non Ratepayers & Developers \$160 per hour- \$80.00 Minimum Charge plus PST. Work Authorization Form must be filled out before any work will be performed. If you rely on the rural municipality for custom work, please note that the rural municipality's policy is to clear all roads first before any private custom work is done.

Transfer Station

The Aberdeen Transfer Station will remain open, with some minor changes to operations. To ensure the health and safety of our Transfer Station Attendant during the Covid-19 pandemic, the attendant has been instructed to limit interactions with the public.

The RM council will continue to monitor the situation and may impose changes as needed. Please follow us on Facebook to receive regular updates regarding the Transfer Station and other RM services.

Animals Roaming at Large

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps can be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

Taxes

2020 Taxes will be levied and Tax Notices will be mailed out in June. If you do not receive your tax notice before the end of July, please contact the RM office to obtain a copy. Taxes are due on or before December 31, 2020. A discount of 6% on the municipal portion is offered for payment in July, 5% in August, etc.; no discount is offered in December. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month to receive the corresponding discount.

Controlled Burn

With the dry weather conditions, the RM council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns

- Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
- 2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Please notify the municipality of any change in your mailing address to ensure you receive your tax notice and other important correspondence in a timely fashion.

As Spring cleaning is upon us please remember that back alleys and empty lots are not dumping grounds for debris, leaves, grass clippings, rocks, etc. It makes it very difficult for our Maintenance staff to cut grass and maintain alleys. We thank you for your cooperation.

The Town Council of Aberdeen has passed a resolution to follow suit with the City of Saskatoon to suspend Garage or Yard sales until further notice. **Garage and Yard** sales are not critical public services so in doing our part to flatten the curve of COVID19 we are prohibiting them at this time.

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. There is a 3-page form that needs to be filled out when you take out your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits are required prior to construction beginning for:

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

Thank you to those who already receive their utility bills by email.


