




Assessment Notices

2021 Assessment Notices were mailed out on March 5th, 2021. If you have not received your Notice yet, please contact the office.

The Assessment Notice is the official notice of the assessed value of your property as determined by SAMA. Your assessment notice will have the appeal form on the back of the sheet. The 2021 Deadline to appeal will be May 7, 2021 at 4:30pm. **This notice and time-frame** is the only opportunity for appealing assessments during the year. If you disagree with the property value established by SAMA, there is a formal appeal process available to you. Appeals must be based on an error in your property assessment and not based on the amount of taxes paid for the property. Property reports may be viewed on the SAMA website. Please check our website or Facebook page for updates on the deadline and other important information.

Taxes/ Outstanding Invoices

2020 taxes were due on or before December 31, 2020. All outstanding taxes began collecting a penalty of 1% per month.

Controlled Burn

Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns

- Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
- 2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

Any Delegations wishing to address Council are required to complete a **Delegations Policy form and have it submitted to the Town Office no later than the Thursday prior to Council meeting date**. You may obtain these from the Town Office. These forms are also available on our website <u>www.aberdeen.ca</u>

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. A 3-page "Energy Efficiency Compliance" form needs to be completed and submitted with your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits

Are required prior to construction of;

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

We remember those who died, or were injured or made ill, from their work

We commit to protecting workers and preventing further workplace tragedies



On April 28th, 2021 the Town of Aberdeen will once again recognize the Federal and Provincial Day of Mourning by lowering the flags.

The preliminary statistics for 2020 indicate that there were 34 work related deaths in the Province of Saskatchewan. Most are related to occupational disease (16), followed by traumatic incidents (7), motor vehicle (7) and heart attacks (4).

There will be no public meeting in the Town this year and our thoughts and thanks go out to all of the workers world-wide who remain at work to protect the health and safety of others while putting themselves at risk during this world pandemic. The pandemic has touched nearly every aspect of the world of work, from the risk of transmission of the virus in the workplaces to risks that have emerged as a result of measures to mitigate the spread of the virus including psychosocial risks and violence in particular.

The annual day for Safety and Health at work promotes the prevention of occupational injury and diseases globally. It is part of a campaign to raise awareness and intended to focus international attention on the magnitude of the problem and on how promoting and creating a safe and healthy culture in the workplace can reduce the number of work-related deaths, illnesses and injuries. Its purpose is to honor the memory of victims of occupational incidents and diseases.

While we honor the injured, the ill and the fallen workers on April 28th, we recognize the day as one for commemoration and for mobilization, we must also recognize that these injuries and fatalities can be prevented by having a strong health and safety culture in our workplaces.

- Over 100 countries recognize a world day for safety and health at work on April 28th.
- In 1988 Saskatchewan proclaimed The Victims of Workplace Injuries Day of Mourning Act.
- In 1990 the Federal Government passed the Workers Mourning Day Act.
- In 2003 the International Labour Organization (ILO) recognized the International Memorial Day to
 promote health and safety as a basic human right across the globe.




