




Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date of issue. If a permit extension is required, please submit your request in writing to the RM office.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that inspections are completed as per the review plan and that Building Permits are closed in a timely manner.

Custom Work is available to ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen for snow removal, driveway grading and land leveling. A work authorization form is required prior to any work being done by the RM. Please contact the office or visit the website for more information.

Controlled Burn

Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns

- Register with the municipality: call 306-253-4312 or 306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.
- Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

COUNCIL'S CORNER

Town Council meetings are open to the public.

We meet at the TOWN OF ABERDEEN Office Chambers, 401C Main Street, 7:00 pm every 3rd Tuesday of the Month. Our next council meeting is scheduled for Tuesday June 15, 2021.

Any Delegations wishing to address Council are required to complete a Delegations Policy form and have it submitted to the Town Office no later than the Thursday prior to Council meeting date. You may obtain these from the Town Office. These forms are also available on our website www.aberdeen.ca

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. A 3-page "Energy Efficiency Compliance" form needs to be completed and submitted with your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits

Are required prior to construction of;

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

Completing your Census is important for Aberdeen....we receive many types of grant funding on a per capita basis! The deadline to complete SAMA's data collection form is May 30. Please complete the form to help ensure accuracy on your property assessment for 2022.

Representatives from SAMA (Sask Assessment Management Agency) will be out in the neighborhoods doing their property assessment Inspections for 2022. They will be wearing their government issued ID, and will be working in Aberdeen for the next month or so. (They may knock on the door and ask questions or enter the yard to take measurements. They will not be entering the house).
