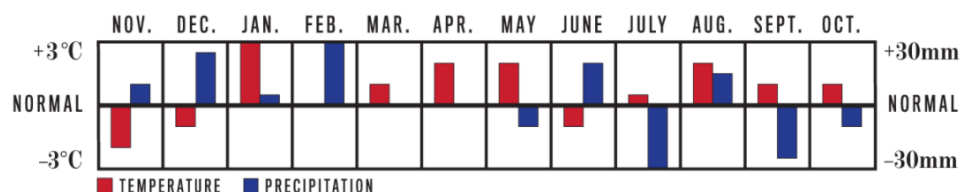

## **Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Association**

Owners of land may withdraw all, but not part, of their cultivated land from the operations of the Municipal Hail Insurance Act by filing a withdrawal application with the Association on or before March 31st.

## **Building Permits**

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date of issue. If a permit extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM office.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that inspections are completed as per the review plan and that Building Permits are closed in a timely manner.

### **Controlled Burn**

*Don't forget to register your Controlled Burns*

1. Register with the municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603 after hours and weekends.**
2. Register with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.**

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

### **Pest Control Officer**

As the weather turns colder, rats will be looking for a warm place to stay and a steady source of food. If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

### 2021 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2021 are due December 31, 2020, and are valid until December 31, 2021.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200.

Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

## TaeKwon-Do

The Dynamic TaeKwon-Do Club meets every Monday and Thursday upstairs in the ARC. Under the excellent guide of Head Instructor Myron Peters, students of all ages learn about the Korean Martial Art. From the Pastor's desk:

It's been nearly a year since the pandemic turned our lives upside-down. So many things have changed! It's hard to remember what it was like to get together in large groups the way we used to. And at the church, that was a large part of our regular routine. Sunday mornings aren't the only reason for the church to exist, but as a group, much of our identity is tied to those weekly gatherings. One of the things we did to adapt to the new pandemic reality was to hold outdoor, drive-in worship services. Using a low-power radio transmitter, folks could get the sound through their vehicle's radio. When we moved back into the church building when the weather turned cold, we faced a limit of the number of people allowed inside. We continued to use the radio transmitter and some people have listened to the service from their vehicle outside the church building.
