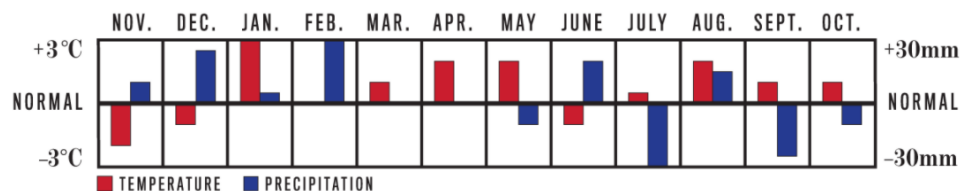

The September Council meeting will be held the Second Thursday of the month. Meetings will start at 8:00 am. Council Meetings are available for viewing via Facebook Live or in person. Any delegations wishing to address the council will be required to contact the office by the Friday prior to the meeting.

Taxes/ Outstanding Invoices

2021 taxes are due on or before December 31, 2021. Discounts apply in July (6%), August (4%) and September (2%). All outstanding invoices will begin collecting a penalty of 1% per month after 90 days of issue.

Emergency Services

In case of an emergency please call 911. Ensure that you are familiar with your Civic Address and Land Location in order to aid the emergency services in a quick response time to your location.

Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis, at 306-220-8996. Denis is conducting site visits and will be going around to all yard sites doing inspections. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours.

Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for 12 months from the date of issue. If a permit extension is required, please submit your request in writing to the RM office.

It is the responsibility of the landowner to ensure that inspections are completed as per the review plan and that Building Permits are closed in a timely manner.

2. Register with the **Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.**

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, we will be forced to fine you \$500. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighboring municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have adequate Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

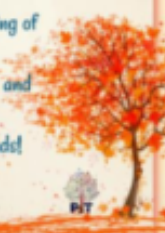

Our Bylaw Enforcement Officer will be monitoring bushes and trees that are over hanging your property as they are damaging town equipment. Please ensure your trees are trimmed back in your back alleys, as well as around your front yard or hindering your neighbours.

Failure to comply with this bylaw will result in a ticket of \$50.00 being issued. Thanks for your cooperation.

As per **bylaw 01-19** (9) (a) "no person shall park or leave parked a recreation vehicle on a residential street in the Town of Aberdeen for more than seventy two (72) consecutive hours."

Bylaw 01-2020 to amend Nuisance Bylaw 02-06 " : e) "junked vehicle" means any automobile, tractor, truck, trailer or other vehicle that i) either; (1) has no valid license plate or is not insured through personal home insurance or auto package policy"

Nuisance Bylaw 02-06

Untidy and Unsightly Property

Notwithstanding the generality of Section 5, no person shall cause or permit any land or buildings to become untidy and unsightly.

Junked Vehicles

Notwithstanding the generality of Section 5, no person shall cause or permit any junked vehicle to be kept on any land owned by that person."

Zoning Bylaw – 07-2014

4.14 STORAGE OF MATERIALS AND UNLICENSED OR INOPERATIVE MOTOR VEHICLES

In any Residential district:

4.14.1 No front yard shall be used for the storage of unlicensed or uninsured motor vehicles or of materials or goods of any type.

4.14.2 No yard shall be used for storage or collection of hazardous material.

4.14.3 No yard or portion thereof shall be used for the storage of machinery not normally used for the maintenance of the residential property.

Just a reminder for anyone getting a new pet, the Maximum number of cats and dogs in your household is limited to 3 in total, bylaw 03-19. A pet license is only \$25.00 and good for the lifetime of that pet.

Pet owners, please be mindful of others and keep pets on your own property. Bylaw Enforcement receives numerous complaints every week about animals running at large. Fines will be imposed against pet owners not following our Animal Control Bylaw.

REPORT SPEEDERS / CRIMES

If you come across vehicles speeding in Town or some criminal activity, please call RCMP directly at: (306) 310-RCMP or (306) 310-7267.

Fence installation – Currently the Town of Aberdeen does not require a Development Permit to construct a fence, as per Bylaw 04/15 and Bylaw 12/19, however we still require residents to follow the requirements for fences noted within our Zoning Bylaw section 4.7.

4.7.3 No wall, fence or other structure not otherwise permitted shall be erected in a required front yard or on a site line adjacent to a required front yard to a height of more than 1.0 metres above grade level.

4.7.4 No wall, fences, screen or similar structure, excepting permitted accessory buildings, shall be erected in a required side or rear yard, or on a site line adjacent to a required side or rear yard to a height of more than 2.0 metres above grade level.

ABERDEEN & DISTRICT FIRE & RESCUE

Smoke alarms DO save lives; they do not save lives if there is NO battery or a DEAD battery in it. Batteries should be replaced every 5 years. If not sure on the date of the battery, simply write the date on it with a marker. Carbon Monoxide alarm should be replaced every 10 years. There should be a manufacture date on both alarms.

Tis the season for camping. Do you have a working alarm in your RV? RVs are a second home; have a working alarm in it also. Remember, have a meeting spot outside in case of alarm and exit home/RV on hands and knees if smoke is thick. If not sure you have a working alarm or have any questions, please ask one of your local fire fighters and we will be glad to help.

ATTENTION FARMERS

As we all know this has been a very dry farming season. We ask, with harvest soon approaching / here, that you be prepared for the worst-case scenario, whether it be an implement fire or grass fire. Have on your equipment at least a 10lb extinguisher and/or water pack. If you have a water tank--keep it full, and water pump--full of fuel. Have your cultivator easily accessible for quick hook-up for grass fire. Do you have a gas leaf blower? Leaf blowers also help in smaller grass fires-- blow the fire back into the burnt area. Keep it fueled and ready to go.

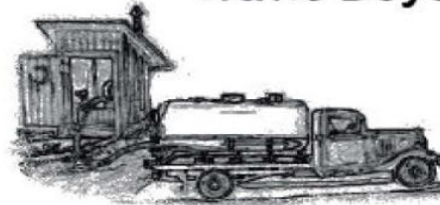

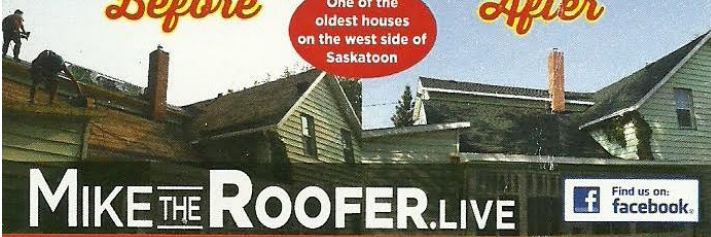

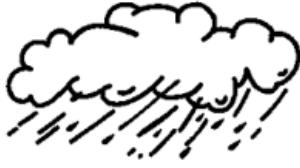
