

Did You Know?

Over 125 miles of roads maintained by the RM are considered bus routes.







We strive to provide a fair and equal service during and after snowstorms.

Our main high traffic grid roads, along with our country residential developments, receive top priority. Bus routes encompass our whole road network, so they get cleared as a matter of course with all other roads, but in extreme conditions bus routes are given priority. Not everyone can be first served, but we do alternate our routes each time out to be as fair as possible.

If you rely on the Rural Municipality for custom work, please note that the Rural Municipality's policy is to clear all roads first before any private custom work is done.

Bylaw Beat:

Bylaw 2018-01 – A Bylaw to Restrict the Placement of Snow Cleared from Private Lands on Roads

When clearing snow from private property, including but not limited to driveways, snow shall not be piled:

- On the road way
- Anywhere within the road allowance, including the ditch, to a height higher than one (1) foot below the lowest part of the roadway

Aberdeen Transfer Station:

Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10:00am to 4:00pm (November-February)
Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10:00am to 5:00pm (March-October)

Blucher Transfer Station:

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:00pm to 7:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am to 5:00pm

User cards are required to utilize the Transfer Stations. If you do not have a current Transfer Station user card, please contact the office at 306-253-4312 or through email to rm373@sasktel.net. Cards can be mailed out or picked up in person.

It's never too early for a SNOW REMOVAL PLAN

Snow removal will be done on roadways from Monday thru Friday, and weekends by necessity only. Sand/gravel will be spread on streets and corners where icy, and as needed to help diminish potential risks to our residents and vehicular traffic.

Priority 1: School Route – Central Avenue, Main Street, Second Avenue and Thompson Street

Priority 2: Emergency Services – Industrial Drive, Fifth Avenue South

Priority 3: Residential Streets, Main Street Sidewalk

Priority 4: Alleys where required.

Back alleys are Town property and NOT a storage area! Bylaw Enforcement will be visiting any property owners who have left items in the alley. Please clear your back alley before snow falls for proper snow removal.

Bylaw Enforcement

2025 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2025 are due December 31, 2024, and are valid until December 31, 2025.

License fees:

Home Based Business- \$25/year Store Front Business- \$75/year Contractor- \$100/year General Contractor- \$300/year (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200. Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance. Forms can be found on www.aberdeen.ca

UPDATES:

- The old lagoon decommission is COMPLETE
- The Water Pumphouse Project has been scheduled to begin in the Spring of 2025 and completion is set for 2026. This new pumphouse will have a 3 days supply of water held in a new reservoir to offset any possible disruptions to the water supply coming to town.
