### Unpaid Taxes & Invoices

2023 Taxes and Invoices were due **December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023**.

As of January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, all unpaid balances were applied to tax accounts as arrears and are subject to a penalty of 1% per month.

### Custom Work

Custom Work is available to Ratepayers in the RM of Aberdeen for snow removal, driveway grading, and land leveling. A Work Authorization Form is required prior to any work being done by the RM. Please visit our website for more information.

### Plowing Snow

We would like to remind everyone that plowing snow onto or across Municipal right-of-way is not a permitted practice. Snow must be pushed onto or piled on your own property. Guilty parties will be subject to fines. Please familiarize yourself with our Snow Removal Policy and Snow Clearing Bylaw No. 2018-01.

### Garbage & Recycling Bins

If you have a rollout cart for garbage pickup, please remember to move your cart back onto your property after garbage day. Garbage carts left on the road or municipal right-of-way pose a hazard to motorists and snow plow machinery. Our road crew cannot fully clear roads if there are obstacles on the roadway after scheduled garbage pickup. Carts damaged by passing vehicles are the sole responsibility of the owner.

### Transfer Station

Winter (November – February) hours are in effect.

### Emergency Services

In case of an emergency, please call **911**. Ensure that you are familiar with your Civic Address and Land Location in order to aid the emergency services in a quick response time to your location.

### Building Permits

Building permits are only valid for **12 months** from the date on the permit. All expired permits must be closed in a timely manner. If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office.

Contact BuildTECH Inspections at **306-370-2824** to book your inspection.

### Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns:

1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline – Fire Chief) after hours and weekends.
2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at **1-866-404-4911**.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality *and* the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined **\$1000**. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring Municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

### Animals Roaming at Large

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the RM, steps will be taken to detain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

### Pest Control Officer

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis at **306-220-8996**. Denis conducts site visits in the spring and summer months. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours. **\*please bring your own bag for poison\***

## 2024 Business Licenses

According to Bylaw 12/14 the Business License Bylaw, all Home Based, Store Front and Contractor Business Licenses for 2024 are due December 31, 2023, and are valid until December 31, 2024.

License fees:

Home Based Business \$25 annually

Store Front Business \$75 annually

Contractor \$100 annually

General Contractor \$300 (covers the trades, as part of the building permit)

The offence for conducting business without a Business License is \$200.

Bylaw Enforcement will be issuing fines for non-compliance.

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

**Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes**

**Tax Estimate Notices for 2024 taxes will be sent in December 2023. 2024 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.**

## SNOW REMOVAL POLICY AND PROCEDURES



### POLICY:

The Public Works/Maintenance Department is responsible for the removal of snow from all Roads, Main Street sidewalks, and Alleys where required, upon their discretion. This policy is intended to be a general outline of the procedures to be followed.

Snow removal will be done whenever there is an accumulation of snow that warrants use of town equipment and at the discretion of our Public Works/Maintenance Department from Monday thru Friday, and weekends by necessity only. Sand/gravel will be spread on streets and corners where icy, and as needed. A layer of snow on roadways will remain for the protection of our underground infrastructure.

**Priority 1** School Route – Central Avenue, Main Street, Second Avenue and Thompson Street

**Priority 2** Emergency Services – Industrial Drive, Fifth Avenue South

**Priority 3** Residential Streets, Main Street Sidewalk

**Priority 4** Alleys where required

### RESIDENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

Residents may help by clearing the front of their property where sidewalks exist. Bylaw 03/13 prohibits residents from placing any snow, ice, dirt or other obstruction, swept or cleaned from private property onto any street, sidewalk, lane, ditch, drain or sewer.

Many times the Town Office receives calls from residents regarding the snow removal equipment depositing snow at the end of driveways. Unfortunately, this is a reality of snow plowing, and it cannot always be avoided. If you have a neighbor who is unable to remove their snow from in front of their driveway please assist them, as we often do not have the resources to go back and clear driveway approaches. We ask for your cooperation and understanding as our staff performs the work of keeping our streets open and safe during the winter.

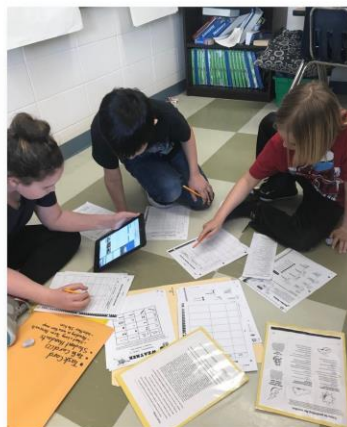

## Globe Walk Challenge

Challenge yourself and others who are 50+ to participate in a fun winter physical activity routine.

**Stroll or roll, hike or bike, gym or swim - all physical activity counts! also includes**

Vacuuming, making your bed, walking stairs, playing with grandchildren

We'll begin January 1, 2024 and count kilometers travelled through physical activity until April 30, 2024.

**15 minutes = 1300 Steps = 1KM**

At month end give your team captain the KM travelled through physical activity. The team Captain submits totals online.

**Example to convert time to KM:** Eg. 300 min divided by 15 = 20 KM or 5 hours divided by 0.25 = 20km

The Saskatoon Council on Aging is a community leader promoting positive aging for all, in an age-friendly community.

During community consultations for the Age-Friendly Saskatoon Initiative, older adults identified the need for more physical activity during the winter months. The Globe Walk Challenge is a response to that need.

## What are you waiting for? How to Join

**Step 1:** If you are on a team, go to Step 2. If you want to be a Team Captain, join the SCOA Team or form your own team, phone SCOA 306.652.2255.

**Step 2:** Fill out the form on the reverse of this brochure and give it to your Team Captain.

**Step 3:** Keep track of your distance, steps or time. Remember that all forms of physical activity count [not just walking] and that every 1 kilometre = 30 minutes of exercise.

**Step 4:** At month end, give your totals [distance or time] for that month to your Team Captain. The Team Captain submits team totals to SCOA Globe Walk Coordinator.

**Step 5:** Get motivated, have fun, invite friends and family to take part and join everyone for a celebration party at the end of the Globe Walk.

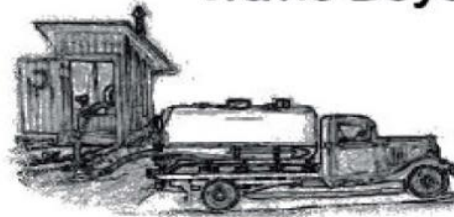
