

Tax Notices

2024 Taxes are being levied and Tax Notices will be mailed out in **June**. If you have not received your notice by July, please contact the RM Office. Taxes are due on or before **December 31st**, **2024**. A discount of **6%** on the municipal portion of taxes is offered for payments made by *July 31st*, **4%** by *August 31st*, and **2%** by *September 30th*. All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month.

If an extension is required, please submit your request in writing along with your signature and the itemization of the work still required to be completed to the RM Office.

If you suspect a rat infestation on your property or on a neighbouring property, please call Denis at **306-220-8996.** Denis conducts site visits in the spring and summer months. Rat poison can be picked up at the office during regular business hours. *please bring your own bag for poison*

Controlled Burn

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Do not forget to register your burns:

- 1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** or **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline Fire Chief) after hours and weekends.
- 2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at **1-866-404-4911**.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality *and* the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined \$1000. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring Municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Emergency Services

In case of an emergency, please call **911**. Ensure that you are familiar with your Civic Address and Land Location in order to aid the emergency services in a quick response time to your location.

Transfer Station

March – October hours are in effect. The Aberdeen Transfer Station is open Wednesdays and Saturdays from **10:00am until 5:00pm.** If you do not have a current Transfer Station card, please contact the office at **306-253-4312** or through email. Please check the RM of Aberdeen website for a list of accepted materials.

All new buildings and additions greater than 100 square feet in building area are required to meet the National Energy Code of Canada. A 3-page "Energy Efficiency Compliance" form needs to be completed and submitted with your building and development permits. This 3-page form is not required for unheated detached garages or sheds.

Building Permits

Are required prior to construction of;

All New Dwellings, Garage, Sheds – 100 sq ft & over (10x10 or larger), Decks, Additions, Basement Development, Structural changes to existing buildings.

Are required prior to installation of solar panels on existing roof structures


2024 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

For prompt payment of 2024 taxes the following discounts are allowed:

Payments received in January 6.5% discount Payments received in February 5.5% discount Payments received in March 4% discount Payments received in April 3% discount Payments received in May 2% discount

Payments received in June 1% discount

Payments received in July .5% discount



Penalties for 2024 Tax arrears will be as follows:

August 1 (compounded monthly) 1%
September 1 1%
October 1 1%
November 1 1%
December 1 1%

On January 1, 2025 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2024 arrears

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax <u>Estimate</u> Notices for 2024 taxes were sent in December 2023. 2024 Tax Notices will be sent mid May, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.





Accepted Products:

Flammable Liquids

(Under 10L / 25L for Gas only)

- · Must display the flammable symbol in an octagon.
- Examples: Acetone, BBQ lighter fluid, gasoline (in a ULC-approved can), paint thinner, etc.

Physically Hazardous

(Fuel cylinders non-refillable - under 5kg)

- Must display the flammable symbol in an octagon and the explosive symbol.
- Examples: Propane cylinders, camp fuel cylinders, MAPP gas torch fuel cylinders.

Aerosols

(Flammable, toxic, pesticides, and/or corrosive)

- Must display the explosive and flammable toxic poison or corrosive symbols in an octagon.
- Examples: Lubricant spray, glue, insect repellent, brake cleaner. (No cosmetic or beauty products.)

Toxic Liquids

(Under 10L)

- Must display the poison symbol in an octagon.
- Examples: Furniture stripper, automotive additives, lubricants.

Pesticides

(Liquids and solids - Under 10L/10kg)

- Must display the poison symbol, a Pest Control Products number, and the word "Domestic."
- Examples: Yard & garden chemicals, antifouling paint, sanitizers.

Corrosive

(Liquids and solids - Under 10L/10kg)

- · Must display the corrosive symbol in an octagon.
- Examples: Rust remover, pool & hot tub chemicals, ammonia, bleach.

Basic Restrictions:

- Household waste only (no industrial or agricultural waste).
- Original containers and labels only.
- Sealed containers only (must be leak-proof).
- Pesticide containers must show the Pest Control Product number, the word "Domestic," and a toxic symbol.
- Not accepted: Motor oil, paint, antifreeze, ammunition, caulking compound, cosmetics, diesel, medical sharps, fertilizer, wet-cell batteries, mercury switches, light tubes and CFL light bulbs.


