

Aberdeen Transfer Station:

Wednesdays and Saturdays from 10:00am to 5:00pm

Blucher Transfer Station:

Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:00pm to 7:00pm and Saturdays from 9:00am to 5:00pm

User cards are required to utilize the Transfer Stations. If you do not have a current Transfer Station user card, please contact the office at **306-253-4312** or through email to rm373@sasktel.net. Cards can be mailed out or picked up in person.

You must have your card with you to access either Transfer Station.

Hail Insurance:

Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance offers discounts on crop insurance that differ from those available on MUN Taxes.

- 5% discount if paid by September 30th, 2025
- 4% discount if paid by October 31st, 2025
- 2% discount if paid by November 30th, 2025

Gravel:

If you believe you have gravel on your property, and would be willing to let the RM conduct testing for it, please reach out to the RM Office either by email or phone for details.

The RM Council would like to remind everyone to take extreme caution while having a controlled burn. Please do not forget to:

1. Register with the Municipality: call **306-253-4312** between 9:00am - 5:00pm Monday-Friday *or* **306-230-1603** (Adrien Hamoline – Fire Chief) after hours and

2. Register with the Provincial Fire Center at 1-866-404-4911.

If a passing motorist reports a fire that you have not registered with the Municipality and the Provincial Fire Center, you will be fined \$1000. If our fire department deems it necessary to call in fire fighters from neighbouring Municipalities, all costs will be forwarded to the person responsible for starting the fire. Please ensure you have proper Fire Fighting Insurance coverage.

Building Permits:

All structures or buildings over **100ft**² require a building permit. Houses or additions require permits regardless of their square footage. All buildings must adhere to the setbacks in our Zoning Bylaw. The zoning of your property will determine the required setbacks.

Town Council meetings are open to the public.

Council meetings are held at the TOWN OF ABERDEEN Office Chambers, 401C Main Street, at 7:00 pm every 3rd Tuesday of the Month.

ICIP- Water Pumphouse Update

To the residents of the Town of Aberdeen,

As many of you are aware, the Town of Aberdeen was awarded funding under the Investing in Canada's Infrastructure Program for a Reservoir and Water Plant expansion. The main objective of this project is to increase our potable water storage supply. With this grant, a new Water Distribution Plant with 2 pump wells, 400 cubic meters of additional storage, piping, electrical and updated mechanical controls will be built.

The application for funding was applied for in the amount of \$3,415,000 with the total Federal and Provincial contribution being \$2,504,220.

Due to an increase in overall construction costs from the time of application to tendering out the project, the overall cost of the project increased from \$3,415,000 to \$4,376,000.

After lengthy discussions and review of the difference in cost for the project, Council has made a motion to instate a project based borrowing loan. This offers the Town a line of credit to be utilized only for the above noted project. Once the project is complete, only the amount used will be applied to a loan.

Council continues to work with our financial institution to ensure repayment of the loan will be covered by the Infrastructure Fee already set up on the current utility bills issued. 401C Main Street, PO Box 130

Please take note:

In accordance with Bylaw 01-19, A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO REGULATE THE OPERATION AND THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AND THE USE OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS

Section 3(e)(9)(a) no person shall park or leave parked a recreation vehicle on a residential street in the Town of Aberdeen for more than seventy two (72)consecutive hours following which the owner or operator shall move the recreational vehicle to an off street location for a period of not less than forty-eight (48) consecutive hours before the recreational vehicle may be parked again on a residential street.

Section 3(e)(10) no person shall park or leave parked at any time, a trailer which is detached from the vehicle used for moving the same, unless the trailer is a recreational vehicle to which Subsection (9)(a), (9)(b), (9)(c) and (9)(d) applies.

2025 MONTHLY TAX DISCOUNTS / PENALTIES:

Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

Please remember there is NO discount for the School Portion of Taxes

Tax Estimate Notices for 2025 taxes will be sent in January 2025. 2025 Tax Notices will be sent mid May/ beginning of June, once the School Division levies have been established and the Municipal Mill Rate has been set.




