2026 MUN Tax Discounts:

January 1st - July 31st: 6% | August 1st - August 31st: 4% | September 1st - September 30th: 2% | October 1st - December 31st: 0%

Tax Notices:

2026 Taxes are being levied and Tax Notices will be mailed out in **July**.

If you have not received your notice by **July 15th, 2026**, please contact the RM Office. Taxes are due on or before **December 31st, 2026**.

All payments must be received or the envelope date stamped by Canada Post on or before the last day of the month to be eligible for the discounts listed above.

Hail Insurance:

Saskatchewan Municipal Hail Insurance offers discounts on crop insurance that differ from those available on MUN Taxes.

- **5% discount if paid by September 30th, 2026**
- **4% discount if paid by October 31st, 2026**
- **2% discount if paid by November 30th, 2026**

June 15th, 2026 is the last day to file SMHI crop reports. Crop reports can also be filed online on municipalhail.ca using the File Crop Report option. If you have questions about hail insurance, please contact our CAO. CAO Bridgette Shwytky is a licensed agent in both SMHI & Additional Municipal Hail Insurance (AMHI).

Bylaw Beat:

Bylaw No. 9101 – Bylaw to Establish a Haying Policy:

The adjacent landowner or lessee in the case of rented land, has first option to salvage hay along municipal roads. Other persons must contact the adjacent landowner or lessee to salvage the hay before **July 15th** each year.

After **July 15th**, any person may cut and salvage hay without the permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee, provided the adjacent landowner has not begun salvage operations.

In accordance with this bylaw, please be aware that there are roads in the municipality that are not mowed until after July 15th to allow for hay salvage.

Did You Know?

Ratepayers in the RM are eligible to receive one free summer driveway blading per year if both the driveway and yard can accommodate the size of the grader. While free, a Custom Work Authorization form is still required for this service.

Pest Control:

The RM's appointed Pest Control Officer is Denis Boyenko. Denis conducts site visits throughout the spring and summer months. Please report rat infestations to Denis directly at **306-220-8996**.

Fun Fact:

The Columbarium was installed at the Aberdeen Community Cemetery in 2019.

Gravel:

If you believe you have gravel on your property, and would be willing to let the RM conduct testing for it, please reach out to the RM Office for details.

Building Permits:

All structures or buildings over **100ft²** require a building permit. Houses or additions require permits regardless of their square footage.

All buildings must adhere to the setbacks in our Zoning Bylaw. The zoning of your property will determine the required setbacks.

- Site Plan
- Building Plans
- \$100 Permit Application Fee
- SaskHealth Sewage Permit Number
- Energy Efficiency Compliance Form

Each 10' x 10' can be divided into two 5' x 10' plots.

5' x 10' plot: **\$200**

Columbarium niches are **12.5" x 12.5" x 14"**.

Each niche is designed to hold two urns.

Columbarium niche: **\$1000**

(incl. cost of name & date plaques)

ICIP- Water Pumpouse Update

The majority of our pumphouse exterior has now been complete with the hopes of being operational by October of 2026! We are very excited for the completion of this huge project and are looking forward to what this will help provide for in the Town of Aberdeen and its growth.

ONE VERY LARGE BENEFIT

The current available storage at our Water Pumpouse is held in two reservoirs. The combined holding storage of both reservoirs is 602 cubic meters. This is equal to 602,000 litres or 132,421 gallons. Now, with the average use of 325 litres per day per capita (according to the Water Security Agency), and using the estimated population of 762, this means the Town of Aberdeen is using approximately 247,650 litres per day. Using these estimates, it is safe to say the Town of Aberdeen holds approximately a 2-day water supply for the residents should our supply line be disrupted.

As the Town of Aberdeen continues to grow, there is an estimated fluctuation to 884 residents by 2035. In 2019 our new Lift Station and Lagoon were designed with this in mind as well, built to accommodate a growth of 1200 residents. The Town of Aberdeen now will match that growth with our water distribution.

The addition of an additional reservoir and pumpwell will increase our active storage to 1108 cubic meters or 1,108,000 litres or 243,726 gallons. With the current usage stats listed above, this means we will have enough water capacity to continue distribution to the residents for 4.5 days should there be a disruption. If our population is to land at approximately 1100 people, we will still maintain a 3-day water supply.

DID YOU KNOW...

On January 1, 2027 a 12% penalty will be applied to 2026 arrears	

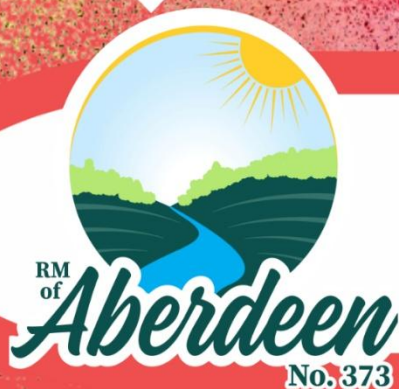
Taxes are imposed the first day of January in each year and are due July 31.

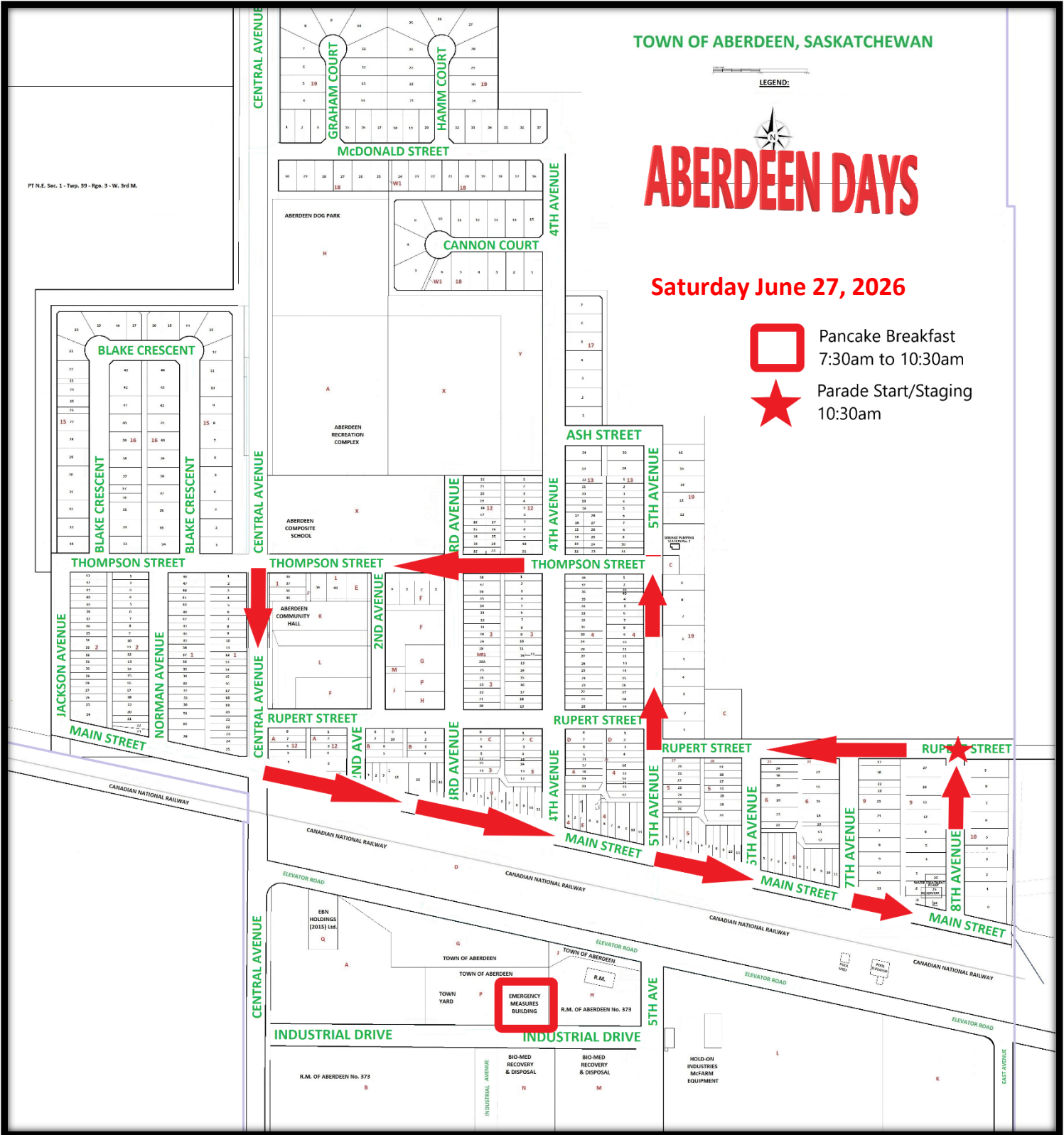

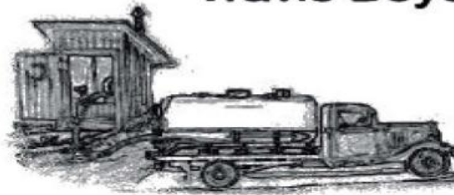
